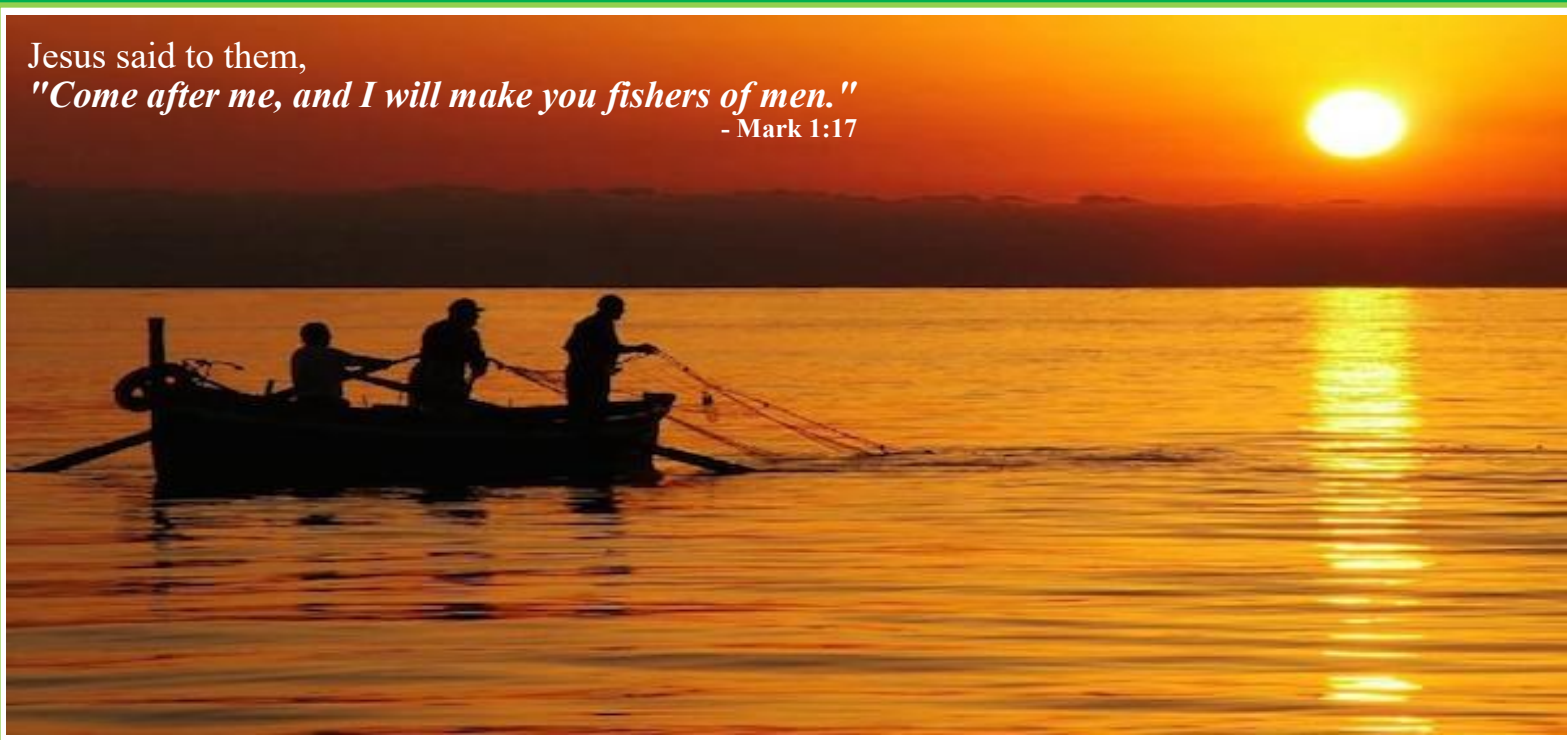

From Fr. Mike's Desk

"The word of the Lord came to Jonah saying, 'Set out for the great city of Nineveh and announce to it the message that I will tell you.' So, Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh." Last week we read about the Divine call to Samuel and the call of the first disciples from John's Gospel. Today we see two more examples of God calling people.

Our first reading tells how God called the Prophet Jonah to preach to the city of Nineveh that the end was near because of their many sins. We also see in the Gospel another version of the call of the first disciples, but this week it is from Mark's Gospel. In today's account, John the Baptist does not point out Jesus. No, Jesus directly went to Simon and Andrew and said to them, "**Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.**" Jesus calls them to abandon their old way of life and follow Him in His mission to call people to salvation. Observe, as Mark tells us, that before Jesus called Simon and Andrew, James, and John, He heard about the arrest of John the Baptist. John's arrest stirred Jesus to begin the Public Ministry. Our Lord's first act is to declare the Kingdom of God is at hand and people should repent and believe in the Good News. This week the call to discipleship reminds us that this is a call to action. Last week reminded us that the call comes to us in the quiet spaces of our lives (which was true for Samuel, Andrew, and John), but it is also true for Simon, James, and Jonah this week. Why? Because God first called Jonah in the quiet spaces of his life and one can assume that the same is true for all those called by God. Certainly, they had moments of quiet when they knew God was calling them, or else they would not have been able to leave it all behind to follow God's command or Jesus in His ministry. Nevertheless, after the quiet comes the call to action: Jonah went to Nineveh and the Apostles followed Jesus.

Again, remember this call to discipleship is not limited to or restricted to those in Ordained Ministry, Religious Life, or Professional Lay Ministers of the Church. This call is for all Christians, and like the Apostles and Jonah, we are to act. We put the call into action by living out and sharing the Gospel, by following the moral teachings of the Church, and by living out the Beatitudes and Ten Commandments every day. We put the call into action by practicing **the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy**. Just as a reminder, the **Spiritual Works of Mercy are**: To Instruct those ignorant of the Faith; To Counsel the Doubtful; To Advise Sinners; To Bear Wrongs Patiently; To Forgive Offences; To Comfort the Afflicted; and to Pray for the Living and the Dead. **The Corporal Works of Mercy are**: To Feed the Hungry; Give Drink to the Thirsty; Clothe the Naked; Shelter the Homeless; Visit the Sick; Visit those in Prison; and Bury the Dead. Practice all of these and what you are led to through your prayers, and we all can be disciples of faith and action responding to God's call.

At the end of this month, we will celebrate *Catholic Schools Week*, and it promises to be a great week. We will have *Open House* hours where you can come, tour the school, and see all the good things that *St. Edward's School* has to offer your children, grandchildren, cousins, and neighbor's kids. This week, you can meet with our principal, *Mr. Vincent Albrecht*, and many teachers. A Catholic Education provides your child with all they need to know about this world and all they need to know about the world to come. It provides them with all the tools they need to change the world and to do their part in building up the church and the Kingdom of God.



The Pope at Audience This Week

"Beware of lust which enchains rather than embraces, and live the purity of love." Pope Francis gave this admonishment during last Wednesday's General Audience. Continuing his catechesis series on virtues and vices, the Pope focused this week on the sin of lust. The Holy Father recalled that Christian doctrine does not condemn the sexual instinct, saying that falling in love is one of the most beautiful and tender experiences. "If it is not polluted by vice, falling in love is one of the purest feelings," he said. We must have patience, said the Pope, if our love, which is so powerful, may also be a little naive at first. "Lovers do not really know the face of the other; they tend to idealize their beloved; they are ready to make promises whose weight they do not immediately grasp." He concluded by saying "God's gift of sexuality, which finds sublime expression in conjugal love, is at the service of human fulfillment and authentic freedom."

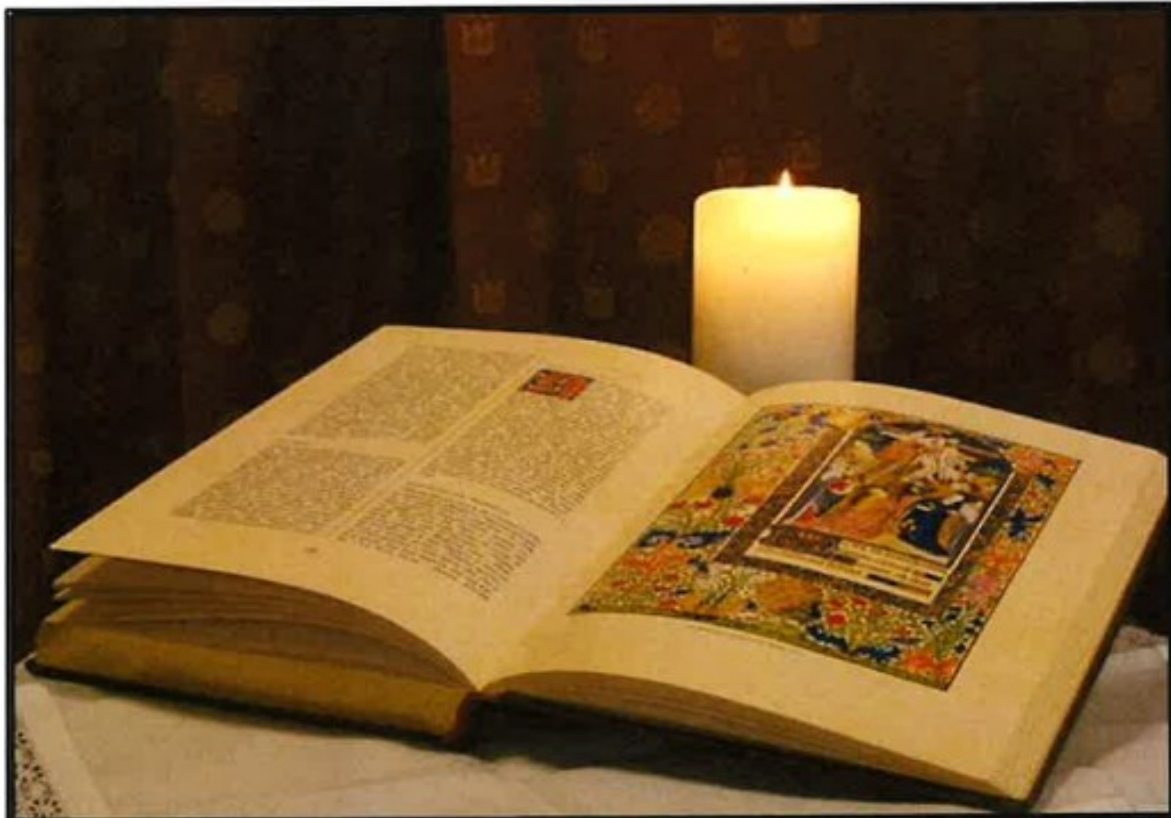

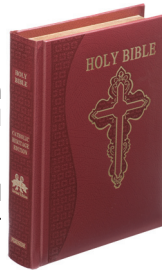
