## From Fr. Mike's Desk

In this space last week, I wrote about prayer and how prayer carried out on a regular basis can bring us into a deeper relationship with God. It can help us to see how much He wishes to share Himself with each of us, even to the point of becoming one of us in the person of Jesus. Yet, for some of us, because of our lack of prayer, we fail to allow God into our lives and resist all of His attempts to become one with us. This can happen to anyone and at any time, even when we can be in prayer. We see this is the story of the Pharisee and the Publican. Jesus tells us about these two men who go up to the Temple to pray.

The Pharisee in his prayer says the following, *“O God I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity – greedy, dishonest, adulterous - or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.”* Whom in fact is he praying to? Is he seeking help from God? Is he praising God, or seeking forgiveness for sins? No, he is not doing any of these things, but he is doing a good job of praising himself. In fact, what this holy man has done in his prayer is replaced God with himself. Our Lord is pointing out that this man has indeed committed a deadly sin, again a sin that anyone of us can commit. We sin when we put our will before God's will, when we do what we want to do, even when we know it will cause harm to others, or ourselves. We do it when we place our self above all things. This is the Pharisee's sin, for he is putting himself, or things, or society before God. Unfortunately, this is all too common an obstacle in our current society, which can be purely materialistic, and consumer oriented. Many of us suffer from the attitude that I want what I want when I want it, and I do not care about anyone else or if it is right or wrong! Years ago, Saint John Paul II labeled our society a culture of death, and he did so because society commits these type of errors right down to the value of human life.

What about the other man who went into the Temple to pray? The Publican, unlike the Pharisee, did not waste his time at prayer. He totally directed his prayer toward God. The Publican was a tax collector for the Roman Empire, and they were traitors to Israel for supporting the occupying forces and they were sinners because they were supporting a false god, namely the Emperor and Rome itself. They were

hated, and they usually avoided respectable areas. Yet, this one still approached God in the Temple. His prayer was justified because he expressed the reality that he was a sinner, and in need of God's love and mercy, and he wants God's help to change his life. Our Lord ends the account with the following instruction and warning for all people from every age and generation. Jesus said, *“I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted.”* Thus, let us listen to this warning and try to see ourselves as God sees us and not to put anything, ourselves, our ideas, opinions or anyone else before God or allow them to take God's place.

This Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup> is the Feast of All Saints' Day, and Saturday November 2<sup>nd</sup>, is the Feast of All Souls. Since All Souls' Day is on a Saturday, we will move our Annual Mass of Remembrance to next Sunday November 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3PM. At that Mass we will pray for all those we commend to God, especially remembering all those who had their funeral Mass of Service celebrated here at St. Edward's during the last year. All are invited to attend and to have your loved ones remembered at all the Masses on All Souls' Day and throughout the month of November, please use the envelopes in your packets.
