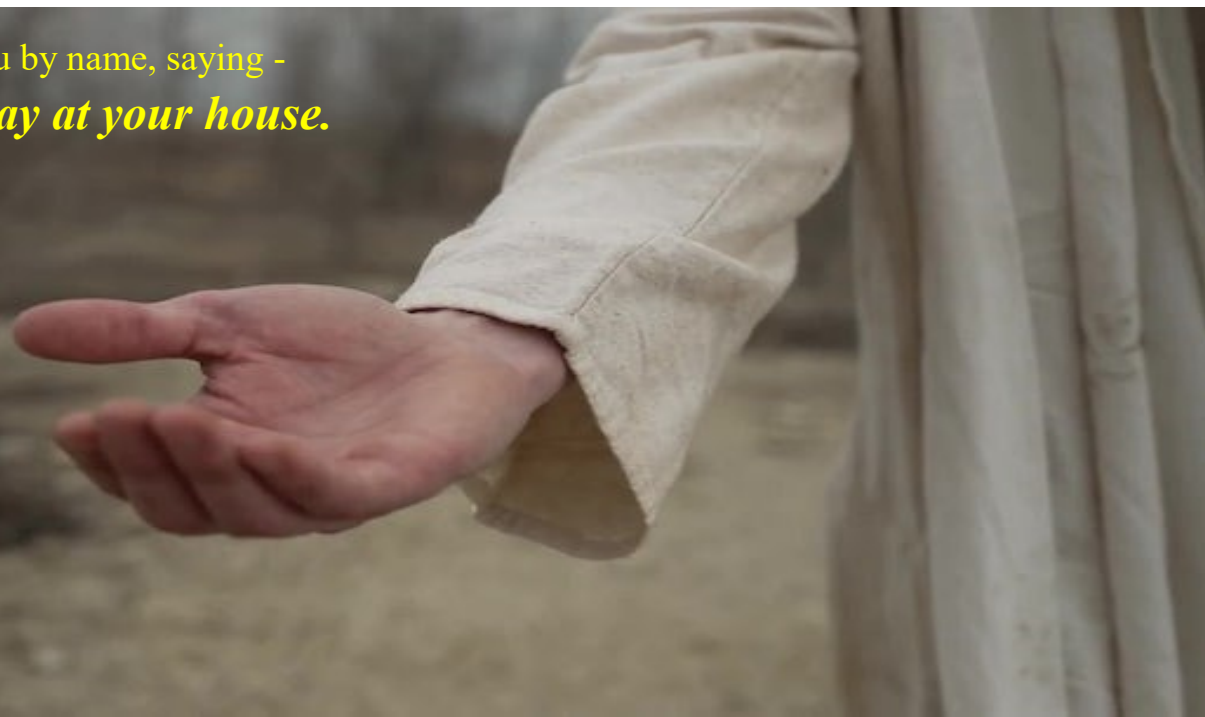

Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reading 1 - Wisdom 11:22-12:2

Before the LORD the whole universe is as a grain from a balance or a drop of morning dew come down upon the earth. But you have mercy on all, because you can do all things; and you overlook people's sins that they may repent. For you love all things that are and loathe nothing that you have made; for what you hated, you would not have fashioned. And how could a thing remain, unless you willed it; or be preserved, had it not been called forth by you? But you spare all things, because they are yours, O LORD and lover of souls, for your imperishable spirit is in all things! Therefore you rebuke offenders little by little, warn them and remind them of the sins they are committing, that they may abandon their wickedness and believe in you, O LORD!

Reading 2 - 2 Thessalonians 1:11-22

Brothers and sisters:

We always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and powerfully bring to fulfillment every good purpose and every effort of faith, that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, in accord with the grace of our God and Lord Jesus Christ.

We ask you, brothers and sisters, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our assembling with him, not to be shaken out of your minds suddenly, or to be alarmed either by a "spirit," or by an oral statement, or by a letter allegedly from us to the effect that the day of the Lord is at hand.

Gospel - Luke 19:1-10

At that time, Jesus came to Jericho and intended to pass through the town. Now a man there named Zacchaeus, who was a chief tax collector and also a wealthy man, was seeking to see who Jesus was; but he could not see him because of the crowd, for he was short in stature. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus, who was about to pass that way. When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." And he came down quickly and received him with joy. When they all saw this, they began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to stay at the house of a sinner." But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, "Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house because this man too is a descendant of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost."

Next Week's Gospel Question

The Sadducees, who deny that there is a resurrection, attempt to ridicule Jesus' teaching about life after death. If we believe in the resurrection, what must we do with our time on earth to be deemed worthy of attaining the resurrection, and become in Jesus' words, "children of God".

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Get ready, it is time for another story about a tax collector! We have not seen this many tax collectors since the last convention of IRS officers. Again, this tax collector is hated by the people, as he supports the Romans and a false god (the emperor). He has a great deal of money, which he acquired off the backs of the people who he has overcharged for years. We, of course, know him as Zacchaeus, who lived in Jericho. While it was not territorially Jewish, many Jews lived there and that was one of the reasons why Jesus was passing through the area. Zacchaeus is also a Jew, which makes his profession even more hateful to the Jews who live there. When he hears that Jesus is coming, he cannot wait to see Him. So, Zacchaeus goes to a place where Jesus will be passing by. We are told that he is short in stature, and he cannot see over the crowds, so he climbs a sycamore tree in order to see this miracle worker from Galilee.

When Our Lord saw him, He said, ***“Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for I must stay at your house.”*** This certainly was unexpected by Zacchaeus and by the people who were gathered around. They immediately criticized Jesus, for He was going to the house of a sinner. We believe that Zacchaeus had a conversion because Jesus called him, and he tells Jesus how he is going to make amends with all those he has cheated. Zacchaeus was willing to repay his debt four times over.

He is a new person, being born again in the spirit, as we see this in the Book of Wisdom from today's first reading; *“O Lord and lover of souls, for your imperishable spirit is in all things! Therefore, you rebuke offenders little by little, warn them and remind them of the sins they are committing, that they may abandon their weakness and believe in you, O Lord!”* As it was with Zacchaeus, so it is with us! God does the same for all of us, and Wisdom is indeed fulfilled with the coming of Jesus. What would we do, what would you do, what would I do, if Jesus said to us, I must stay at your house today! How would you react? Would we be like Martha and fuss over everything, and make sure

everything was perfect. Or would we be just like Mary and sit at the feet of Jesus listening to all He had to say. Would we be like Mathew and leave everything behind to follow Jesus (also just like Peter, Andrew, James, John, and the rest of the 12). But notice what Jesus says to Zacchaeus, I must stay at your house today. Not I would like to stay at your house, **I must. I must stay if you are to be saved.** I wish that Jesus would say these words to me. However, He has said them, and He has said them to all of us. Jesus called us to Himself before we were born, and He sealed us as His own on the day of our Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation. Remember that Jesus is always ready to come over, so invite Him!

Please keep in your prayers all our young adults who will receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit this coming Saturday in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please pray for their sponsors and their families as they use these gifts to invite Jesus in and invite others to follow them and Jesus. Also remember that this Tuesday is November 1st the Solemnity of All Saints, and it is a Holy Day of Obligation. Our Masses will be Monday October 31st at 5PM and Tuesday November 1st at 9 AM, 12:10 PM, and 7 PM. On Wednesday November 2nd we will celebrate the Feast of All Souls Day and we will have our annual Mass of Remembrance Wednesday Night at 7:30 PM. We will remember all of those who died, especially all of those whose Funeral Mass or Service was celebrated this last year at St. Edward's.

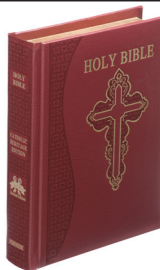
