Gospel – Mark 10:17-30

As Jesus was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus answered him, 'Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: You shall not kill: you shall not commit adultery; you shall not steal; you shall not bear false witness; you shall not defraud; honor your father and your mother." He replied and said to him, "Teacher, all of these I have observed from my youth." Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." At that statement his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus looked around and said to his disciples. 'How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the **kingdom of God!"** The disciples were amazed at his words. So Jesus again said to them in reply, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter *the kingdom of God.*" They were exceedingly astonished and said among themselves, "Then who can be saved?" Jesus looked at them and said, "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God." Peter began to say to him, "We have given up everything and followed you." Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not receive a hundred times more now in this present age: houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come."

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Last month on September 12th, *Saint James* called us to put our faith into action as he wrote, "Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works." James gives us the challenge to move beyond ourselves in our relationship with God and to share that relationship with others. It is also a call to act as Jesus would act toward others who are in need. Today Jesus challenges the rich young man's notion of faith as well as challenging the notion of the gathered people, the Apostles and even you and me.

The Gospel account relates that the young man ran up to Jesus with great excitement and calls Him good teacher. But Jesus does not respond to the young man's flattering words. In fact, Jesus points out to him that only God is good, and that we must never take anything away from God. Notice how Jesus answers the young man's question on what he should do to inherit eternal life. Our Lord tells him that he must go and sell everything he has, give it to the poor and then you will have treasure in Heaven, and then He tells the man to follow Him. The man went off sadly because he had many possessions, and as a result his total focus was on this world. This is what Jesus implies when He tells the Apostles how difficult it is for a rich person to enter into the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus tells the young man correct to follow all the he was Commandments, however, he does place before the young man the challenge that he must change his life and move outside of himself. Likewise, what have we done to change our focus from ourselves to others, to the life that is to come, and most importantly to seek God with all our hearts? Jesus tells him and us to amend our life so you can answer these questions, then we will have eternal life.


Keep in mind, that the young man's problem is not his money or the things he owns, no it is his total dependence on his wealth and maintaining the status quo of this life. It is not that he is a bad person, no remember Jesus looks upon him with love, but he cannot move beyond his comfort zone, even when he is told to do so by the Son of God. But we cannot be too hard on the young man, because he had everything in the world and the people of that time thought that this was a clear sign of Divine favor, and this should carry over into the next life; even the Apostles thought

this way. The young man most likely was looking for Jesus to reaffirm his position in life, and was expecting that he would not have to sell anything. That is why he was surprised at Jesus' answer and why the Apostles were caught off guard and made the comment, who could be saved? Then Jesus tells them, "It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter into the kingdom of God." Jesus is telling them that this thought about wealth and salvation is not God's thought on salvation. Jesus wants them to know that salvation comes from God and it is not based on anybody's wealth or poverty.

Please keep in your prayers our young people who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation during this month. Pray for them that they may be open to receiving all the gifts of the Holy Spirit and move on to become adult members of the Church.
