## From Fr. Mike's Desk

This week's readings confront us with the question; do we think God is listening to us? We see this in the reading from the Book of Exodus with the story of the war with Amalek. We also see it in the Gospel reading, which tells us of the power of prayer. In fact, Luke begins his account with Jesus telling the Apostles about the necessity for them to pray without becoming weary. Then He goes on to tell the story of the Dishonest Judge and the Widow. The judge gave into the widow's constant request because he was afraid that she was going to strike him or worse. Jesus tells us, he acted out of fear and not out of justice, and if people can grant our request out of imperfect motives, just think of how much more God will grant us out of perfect motives.

Now many times we may have said, I asked God for something, and I did not get what I wanted! Therefore, this must mean that God does not really listen to us. Well that is not exactly true, because we must keep in mind that no, is an answer. In addition, there are many times we do not get what we ask for because God, who is perfect, knows that we are better off without the prayer being answered. We must remember that God does indeed answer our prayers but not quite, with what we were expecting. So do not assume He did not listen. Nothing could be further from the truth and we see Him tell us this so many times in the Gospels.

Prayer is a wonderful activity in that it brings us closer to God. The reason why so many people stop praying (in my opinion) on a regular basis is that they see prayer as only being something we do when we have a specific request or demand. On the other hand, perhaps prayers were not answered and so they believe God is asleep at the job. Again, God does not fall asleep on the job, and we must not treat God as if He is Macy's or Amazon. Nor should we treat God as if He is our personal assistant. He does not work for us, in fact as Christians we work for Him. Keep in mind that God loves us and He constantly gives Himself to us. It is only through prayer that we can know and experience this. It is only through prayer that we can have a full relationship with God. If we look at prayer as a daily (and even a constant) conversation with God seeking to know God as God truly is, and not merely as the request or complaint department, then prayer can be the most rewarding part of the day. Prayer also helps us

understand God's will for us and gives us an opportunity to know our best friend, the one whose image and likeness we are all made.

We are rapidly approaching our celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation; it will happen this coming Saturday as we welcome Bishop John O. Barres (the Bishop of Rockville Centre), and part of our preparation for the Confirmandi, is to have an interview with them in the spring. When asked if they pray on a regular basis, many say not really. When I ask why, it is because they see prayer as a chore or something that interferes in their busy life. After all true prayer takes a lot of time and we have to be quiet. However, with every minute of true prayer we gain so much. Wouldn't it be great if we could instill in our young people this practice of truly talking to God and help them to see prayer as what it is, food for our soul, and that it is just as important as food for our bodies. Very few of us neglect our bodies, but we do seem to neglect our soul. This has to change because this life is fleeting and our souls will live on forever, but the question is where will they go when this life is completed? To quote Jesus, **"He who has ears should hear!"**

As you know Friday November 1<sup>st</sup> is the Feast of All Saints' Day, and Saturday November 2<sup>nd</sup>, is the Feast of All Souls. Since All Soul's Day is on a Saturday, we will move our Annual Mass of Remembrance to Sunday November 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3PM. At that Mass we will pray for all those we commend to God, especially remembering all those who had their funeral Mass of Service celebrated here at St. Edward's during the last year. All are invited to attend and to have your loved ones remembered at all the Masses on All Soul's Day and throughout the month of November, please use the envelopes in your packets.

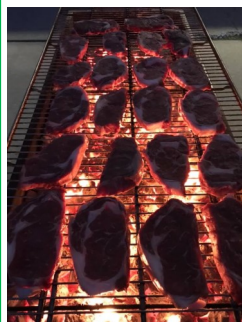

## Prayers of St. Edward's Parishioners Commemorate Miracle of the Sun

On October 13, 1917, thousands of individuals witnessed a miraculous vision near Fatima, Portugal. According to a local newspaper, “Before the astonished eyes of the crowd, whose aspect was biblical as they stood bare-headed, eagerly searching the sky, the sun trembled, made sudden incredible movements outside all cosmic laws—the sun ‘danced’ according to the typical expression of the people.” This experience was confirmed by believers and non-believers alike; the event had been foretold by Our Lady of Fatima to three shepherd children. The Vatican confirmed the authenticity of the miracle and the site has become a source of numerous healings and miracles ever since. Last Saturday, October 12th, the Parishioners of St. Edward gather nearby on Jericho Turnpike to offer their prayers in commemoration of the anniversary of this miraculous event.

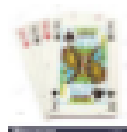

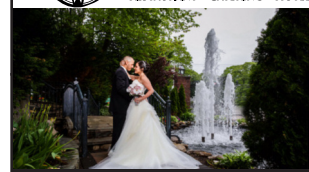

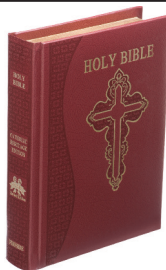
