Brothers and sisters:

Every priest stands daily at his ministry, offering frequently those same sacrifices that can never take away sins. But this one offered one sacrifice for sins, and took his seat forever at the right hand of God; now he waits until his enemies are made his footstool. For by one offering he has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated. Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer offering for sin.

Gospel – Mark 13:24-32

Jesus said to his disciples:

"In those days after that tribulation the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from the sky, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken.

"And then they will see 'the Son of Man coming in the clouds' with great power and glory, and then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the end of the earth to the end of the sky.

"Learn a lesson from the fig tree. When its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you know that summer is near. In the same way, when you see these things happening, know that he is near, at the gates. Amen, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have taken place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

"But of that day or hour, no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father."

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Are you ready for a very important announcement? The world is going to end! Yes, we have heard this before, and we as a Church have been listening to this announcement for over 2021 years. We have heard, we have witnessed, we have waited and yet nothing happens! Well, you can bet on this, it is going to happen, we just do not know when or how. How do we know it is going to happen? That is simple to answer, Christ promised it, Christ spoke about it and in today's Gospel Jesus tells His disciples it will happen.

As we read in Mark today, Jesus says, "In those days of tribulation the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from the sky, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory, and then He will send out the angels and gather His elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the end of the sky." Notice this is not a maybe, Jesus tells us this is a sure thing so be ready. Jesus does include that only the Father knows the day or the hour. So, what are we to do?

The answer to that is to follow what Jesus tells us. We see this when He says, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." Live out the Gospel every day, if we do this and live a life filled with God's love and our love for others, we will find eternal life and we will be in God's Kingdom forever. After 2000 years it is understandable that we may say, this is just a myth, and it really is not going to happen. Keep in mind, that 2000 years is not a long time in total earth history, or in Biblical History and certainly not for God who is timeless. This is what Jesus means when He tells us that only the Father knows, because for God 5000 years ago was this morning.

Jesus also tells the disciples that this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. What does He mean? It could refer to the fact that the early Church saw the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem and the Jewish state at the hands of the Romans in the year 70 AD. But I believe there is more to what Jesus is speaking about. This generation can also refer to us, and to those who will come after us, and it referred to those who came before us. We are all brothers and sisters in the Communion of Saints and that indeed

makes us all members of the same generation. We are all in this together, for we are the generation of the Church, and we are 2021 years old. Now does this mean that only Christians will be saved. No, but it does mean that because we are living out the Gospel, the world will always know about Jesus, and we can help others to come to Our Lord.

So, are we ready to experience eternal life or do we just want to remain here and never totally do what Christ calls us to do? Are we ready to share our faith with others so they too can join us in the Kingdom of God?




