#### First Sunday of Advent

#### Reading 1 - Isaiah 2:1-5

This is what Isaiah, son of Amoz, saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. In days to come, the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established as the highest mountain and raised above the hills. All nations shall stream toward it; many peoples shall come and say: "Come, let us climb the LORD's mountain, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may instruct us in his ways, and we may walk in his paths." For from Zion shall go forth instruction, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. He shall judge between the nations, and impose terms on many peoples. They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks; one nation shall not raise the sword against another, nor shall they train for war again. O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the Lord!

#### **Reading 2 - Romans 13:11-14**

Brothers and sisters: You know the time; it is the hour now for you to awake from sleep. For our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed; the night is advanced, the day is at hand. Let us then throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light; let us conduct ourselves properly as in the day, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in promiscuity and lust, not in rivalry and jealousy. But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the desires of the flesh.

#### Gospel - Matthew 24:37-44

Jesus said to his disciples: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. In those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day that Noah entered the ark. They did not know until the flood came and carried them all away. So will it be also at the coming of the Son of Man. Two men will be out in the field; one will be taken, and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken, and one will be left. Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and not let his house be broken into. So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

#### **Next Week's Gospel Question**

In next week's Gospel John the Baptist preaches in the desert saying to the people, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths." He goes on to tell the Pharisees and Sadducees who are present, "...every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire." On judgement day, what evidence will we be able to provide that shows we have straightened the paths of our own lives? When judged, can we show that, by our conscious efforts, we have produced good fruit?

#### From Fr. Mike's Desk

Here we go again, the beginning of a new Church year, beginning with this First Sunday of Advent. Today, we will bless the wreath, light the first purple candle, and begin our period of waiting. As you know, we are waiting for the coming of Christmas, the Birth of Our Lord and the rebirth of humanity. However, we are also waiting for the Second Coming of Christ, when the Kingdom of God will be fully established, and the world will end.

Last week we celebrated the Feast of Christ the King, and our Gospel reading took us to the cross, where Jesus is reviled by one of the two criminals who were crucified with Him. Picture it, Our Lord is suffering and dying on the cross and this man mocks Him and challenges Him to free Himself and them with Him. With this, the other man dying on the cross, rebukes his fellow thief and turns to Jesus saying, "Jesus remember me when You come into Your kingdom." Our Lord responds with the familiar words (the very words each of us wants to hear), "Amen I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise." While not a pleasant scene, we know that it was necessary for Christ to die on the cross, for if He did not take upon Himself our sins, we could not be saved, and we would not be able to join Him in Paradise.

Today's reading follows with a likewise unpleasant account. It deals with the first type of Advent waiting. While we do this every year, we hope that as each year progresses, we will grow in our faith, we will better understand the Gospel, and most importantly learn to stop living in this world alone and focus on the world that is to come! This first waiting, and how we prepare ourselves, makes today's reading from Matthew's Gospel most appropriate. Why? Because it tells us not to lose focus and always pay attention to Jesus and while the

end of the world seems a long way off, we do not really know this! For all we know it could happen tomorrow, next year, or in another one thousand years. We are instructed to consider that we must not live life like we have all the time in the world. no, we must live life expecting the Lord to come back soon and at any moment. We must be prepared, or we will be caught off guard and it will be too late. Jesus uses the example of the world in the days of Noah, as He says, "In those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying, and giving in marriage up to the day Noah entered the ark. They did not know until the flood came and carried them all away. So will it be also at the coming of the Son of Man...therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come...So too, you must be prepared for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

So, stay awake, be ready, and do not think because it has not happened it will not happen. Stay awake so that this can indeed be a Happy New Year.


