From Fr. Mike's Desk

In John's Gospel today, we are presented with a trial, and like most criminal trials there is a judge and an accused, who will most likely be convicted. One person in this cast of characters will come out alive and completely innocent and the other will be found wanting and on the path to death! But, of the two presented, the one who is the judge and the one who will be found wanting may not be the ones everyone expects as the trial plays out.

Pilate, the Procurator, thinks that he is indeed the judge, and according to all that he has experienced he is. He is Caesar's representative, and he has the power to set the accused free or order him crucified. Jesus, the carpenter from Nazareth, by all appearances, stands as the accused. He is accused of blasphemy and of proclaiming Himself king. This last accusation would put Him in deep trouble with Rome. This is how it all appears, yet it is Pilate, Rome and the world which is on trial, and it is Jesus the Son of the Living God who is the true judge. Pilate has Roman Law as his guide; however, this will pale in comparison with what Jesus will use. He will judge with a truth which can only be found in the Gospel, in the power of God's Love, and in the grace and power of God the Holy Spirit. It is the same truth that calls all people to a new and better life here on earth and in the Kingdom that is to come!

Pilate thinks he is sending Jesus to His death, and this would be the end of the threat to Rome, but we know in sending Jesus to the Cross, he gave Jesus the opportunity to turn death into life. We also know that if Pilate and those on trial with him, did not accept what Jesus did, they themselves have chosen death. Thus, the trial went just as it was supposed to; with the just judge and true king mounting His throne: the Cross, spreading the truth to change the hearts of many, and giving life and forgiveness to all, even those who condemned Him.

Pilate asks Jesus if He is a king, and Jesus replies that He is, adding that His kingdom was not of this world, and totally unlike any kingdom they have ever known. Citizenship in this kingdom requires a desire to seek and live according to the above-mentioned truth, and strong desire to help others come to know and live their lives in accord with the Gospel. We, who are citizens of the kingdom, must remember that while

we were called by God, we were also taught about God and His truth by others who shared their faith with us. Therefore, it is up to us to do the same. Keep in mind that God calls many people to the truth whether they know it or not. It is up to us to try to lead them, not to force them, but to gently lead them. This is what Jesus did during His Public Ministry.

This, the last Sunday of our Liturgical Year, reminds us that Christ came into the world to establish the Kingdom of God. As we celebrate this day, we are also asked to see how well we have made Jesus the focus and King of our lives. If we find we need help in doing this, now is the time to focus on Him, especially as we begin our new year next Sunday with the First Sunday of Advent.

Let us pray, Father All Powerful, God of Love, You have raised our Lord Jesus Christ from death to life, resplendent in glory, as King of Creation. Open our hearts. Free all the world to rejoice in His Peace, to glory in His Justice and to live in His Love. Bring all Humanity together in Christ Jesus, Your Son, whose Kingdom is with You and the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.

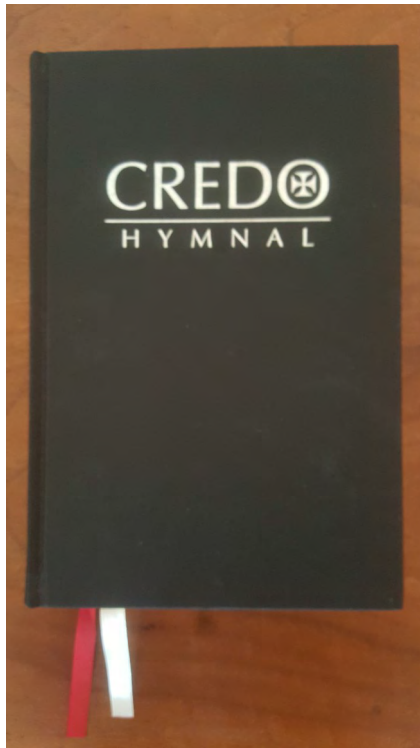

NEW MISSAL / HYMNAL ANNOUNCEMENT



Beginning on the First Sunday of Advent, November 28th, we will be introducing our new Missal/Hymnal called “Credo.” It is a convenient, all-in-one book that will replace the seasonal hymnal that we previously used. This new missal will have the ordinary parts of the Mass in the front, followed by the hymnal, and then the readings for the Mass. All three liturgical cycles are included in this one book. Directions as to what pages you will need to use during the Mass will be posted on the Hymnal Board in the church, and the lector will provide instructions as well. Once the Mass is over, we kindly ask all parishioners to return the missals to the book carts in the gathering area of the church. Please do not leave the missals in the pews.

Aside from the convenience of being a self-contained hardcover missal, it will last much longer. It also comes at considerable savings over the financial cost of the former missalettes, volunteer labor, and is an environmentally friendly solution.

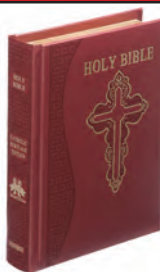
