From Fr. Mike's Desk

At the end of chapter three in the Book of Genesis, we read that after Adam and Eve ate of the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, that God expelled them from the Garden of Eden. As it is written, "The Lord God therefore banished him from the Garden of Eden, to till the ground from which he had been taken. When He expelled the man, He settled him east of Eden; and He stationed the Cherubim and a fiery revolving sword." This account, tells us how sin entered into the human family, and how humanity was expelled from Paradise.

"Jesus, remember me when you come into Your kingdom.' He replied to him, 'Amen I say to vou, today vou will be with me in Paradise."" What an answer to a prayer, but this is not just an answer for the repentant thief, but for every prayer uttered by the human race. By these words and by the actions of our Savior, God removed the great obstacle which sin placed between God and humanity. God destroyed sin, spiritual death, and the darkness that comes from them, and the Church with the singing of Alleluia replaces the sneers of the rulers at the foot of the Cross. Jesus the Christ, the King of Kings has saved us and He did it from the throne of His Cross. He opened the gates of Heaven and bids us to enter into a place far greater than the Garden of Eden. Now the Kingdom of God is open to all who acknowledge Jesus as king of their heart and soul.

Keep in mind, that our King is not one who oppresses anyone or treats us like slaves. Our King does not force Himself on us, no, He allows us to choose life with Him. He is indeed a king who wishes to be in a personal relationship with us, even allowing us to call the one who sent Him, Abba/Father.

This is the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, and it is indeed fitting that we end the year with this acknowledgement of Jesus as our King and the total focus of our lives. As we end this year (just as we do with the end of the secular year) let us look at how far we have grown in the practice of our faith and in our relationship with God. Have we served God with all our heart, soul, mind and in our very being? Have we put ourselves in service to our brothers and sisters? Have we tried our best to avoid sin, have we sought forgiveness of those we have hurt, and have we offered forgiveness to those who have hurt us? After we answer these questions, we will begin next

Sunday, the First Sunday of the year, which is the First Sunday of Advent; we will start the cycle all over again. It is hoped that in starting again, the New Year will be better and we will have grown. As we light the First Advent Candle, we seek to get closer and closer to the world's true light, Jesus our King.

This Thursday November 28, is Thanksgiving Day and we will have Mass at a special time, 10 AM. Please bring any food items you would like to have blessed for your table. We will bless them at this Mass. On behalf of Fr. Hyacinth, Deacons Jim, Barry, and the entire staff of St. Edward's we wish you and your family a very Happy Thanksgiving.






