From Fr. Mike's Desk

Are you ready for a very important announcement? The world is going to end!

Yes, we heard this before, in fact we heard this as recently as two Sundays ago with the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time. As I have mentioned many times the last two weeks of Ordinary Time and the first two weeks of the new Liturgical year and Season, reminds us about the Second Coming of Christ. As you know the Season of Advent has two main themes; one is to prepare us for the Second Coming, and two to get us ready to truly celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior. The two comings of Christ are key moments in our Salvation History. With His birth the last chapter of Salvation History begins as God takes on our total human nature except sin. It continues during the 33 years Christ lived on the earth and it continues in the 2022 years that have followed His life, death, resurrection, ascension into heaven and the sending of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

This last chapter will end when Christ comes again in full glory, where there will be no doubt as to who He is, why He came, and what will be accomplished in His coming as He comes to judge the living and the dead. As we mentioned two weeks ago, many do not believe that Christ will come again because after all these years we have not seen Him, so its just a myth. Bur Jesus challenges this idea as He says in today's Gospel: ***"Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy..."*** And He says do not allow anxieties of daily life cloud your mind that the day will catch you by surprise like a trap. Jesus tells us; when the signs of destruction come, and the Son of Man comes on a cloud with power and great glory, stand erect and raise your heads because our redemption is at hand.

So, are you ready? Jesus tells us, *"Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations...and to stand before the Son of Man."* This will indeed be the end of Salvation History, as all will be fulfilled according to the prophets, the scriptures and all that the Son of God promised. This may seem strange to start the Church's New Year with a repeat of that announcement, that the end will come, but this is really the best way to observe the Church's New Year. Why, because this is what the Church is supposed to do, to build and to serve as the instrument of the Kingdom of God. When this happens, the Church on earth, will be totally

transformed into the Church Triumphant in Heaven.

We close with the opening prayer from today's Mass:

*Grant your faithful, we pray almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at His coming, so that gathered at His right hand, they may be worthy to possess the heavenly Kingdom. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for ever and ever.
Amen*

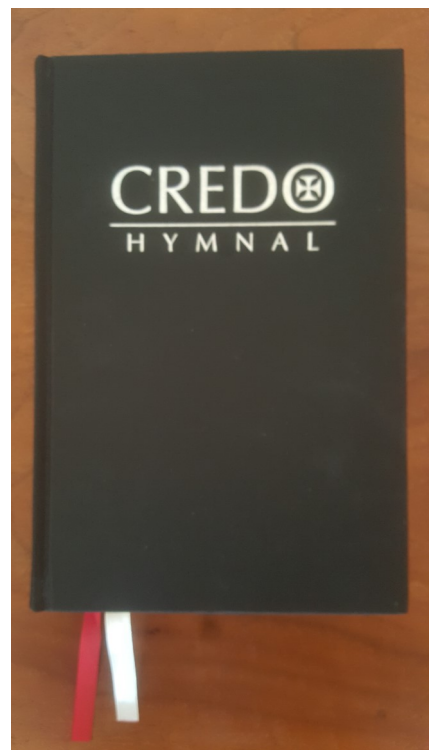

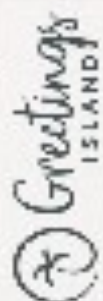

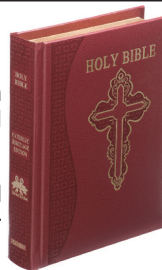
