From Fr. Mike's Desk

The family is the smaller unit from which society develops. As long as the love of God binds the member of the family together, and the Christian virtues rule in our homes, society will be prosperous and at peace. These words come from the Parish Mass Book, St. Joseph's Edition published in 1966 by the Catholic Book Publishing Company. They set the tone for what today's celebration is all about. Yes, we are celebrating the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, but we are also celebrating family life itself. Back in the 1950's and early 60's, the media tried very hard to show us what family life should be like with the programs they offered. Programs like the adventures of Ozzie and Harriet, Leave it to Beaver, My Three Sons, and so many more. Sure, they also showed us families that were not so typical, but they still tried to stress family values. We might remember The Munsters, or the Addams Family, certainly not typical families, but still ones that told us what family life was supposed to be.

As we moved into the 1970's society changed and so did the media's portrayal of family life, we saw this in shows like All in the Family, where we saw and heard Archie Bunker's attitudes. arguments and various expressions. There was also the spin-offs of Maude and The Jeffersons. However, the media never really captured what family life is all about. Whether we were watching on the small screen or the big screen, the family was shown as either being perfect or very dysfunctional. Just look at Honey Bo-Bo; and no, I never watched an episode. This is not what real family life is like. Most families have places where they are indeed perfect and likewise have areas where dysfunctionality really flourishes. Most families have parts of their lives where they struggle and other parts, which are doing well. If you have not noticed, society is the same way. That is why the above selection of words (from the 1966 Mass Book) is perfect for today. Especially when it points out that, the family is the smaller unit from which society develops.

So then how do we make a better society? We must make better families, and how do we accomplish this? We should look at the Holy Family, and we must focus on the values presented to us in the Scriptures. Now we may ask, will doing this make my family perfect? No, but it will make it holy and Christian, and it will give your

family the power to make society a better place. As I mentioned some time ago, Paul gives us the perfect recipe to accomplish this as he writes in today's letter. "Put on, as God's chosen one, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another...And over all these put on love that is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts..."

New Year's Eve Mass at 5PM. On January 1, 2020, the Masses are 9 AM and 12:10 PM. There is no evening Mass on January 1st.



The Meek and Wise Joseph

Addressing the pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square during last week's Sunday Angelus, the Pope reflected on Joseph, "a person apparently in second place, but whose attitude contains the entirety of Christian wisdom." Pope Francis marked the fourth and last Sunday of Advent inviting the faithful to look to Joseph as a model of unshakable faith and trust in the Lord.

Joseph, the Pope recalled, together with John the Baptist and Mary, is one of the characters the liturgy proposes during the season of Advent. Of the three, the Pope noted, he is the most modest: "He does not preach, he does not speak, but he tries to do God's will; and he accomplishes that will in an evangelical style, and in the meek and humble style of the beatitudes. Joseph's poverty, the Pope explained, is typical of those who are aware of their dependence for everything on God in whom they put all of their trust.

Through faith, Pope Francis explained, Joseph understands that the baby conceived in Mary's womb is not his son, but is the Son of God, and he, Joseph, will be His guardian by exercising his earthly paternity. "The example of this good, meek and wise man teaches us to lift up our gaze and look beyond, to trust in God's surprising logic" which consists in openness towards new horizons, towards Christ and His Word.

There is the old Mexican legend about how the poinsettia and Christmas became connected in the first place. Here's how it goes - Once, there was a poor Mexican girl named Pepita who had no present to give the Baby Jesus at Christmas Eve Mass. As Pepita walked, sadly, to the chapel, her cousin Pedro tried to cheer her up. "Pepita," he said. "I'm sure that even the smallest gift, given by someone who loves him, will make Jesus happy."

Still not knowing what she could give, Pepita picked a small handful of weeds from the roadside and made them into a bouquet. Having only this small present to give Jesus made Pepita embarrassed. As she walked through the chapel to the altar, she remembered what Pedro had told her. Feeling a bit better, she knelt down and laid the bouquet at the bottom of the nativity scene.
