From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Oh Come, Divine Messiah! The world in silence waits the day when hope shall sing its triumph, and sadness flees away. Dear Savior haste; Come, come to earth, dispel the night and show your face, and bid us hail the dawn of grace..."

What beautiful words and thoughts we express as we listen to and sing these words from one of my favorite hymns of the Advent Season. This hymn, for me, sets the tone and goal of this season of waiting and anticipation. As you have heard many times, Advent is a season of waiting; it is a season of waiting for the three comings of Christ. We await His First Coming as a child in Bethlehem; we are waiting for His Second Coming at the end of time, and His Third Coming as he comes into our hearts and souls in the here and now. During these four weeks, we will focus on all three comings, with the first two weeks looking at His Second Coming and the last two weeks waiting to celebrate His First Coming 2020 vears ago. While we use the appropriate weeks for His Second and First Comings, we will use all four weeks to focus on His Third coming. We should keep in mind that the Third Coming stays with us for the whole year and for our whole lives but sometimes, we lose sight of it!

This brings us to another well-known aspect of Advent, and that is, this is the beginning of the Church's Liturgical Year. This is a time to start over, a time to look at our lives and see where we have not lived up to God's expectations of us, as we have been told through Jesus. Now is the time to realize, as today's Gospel tells us; we do not know the time or the place when the Second Coming will arrive. Therefore, Matthew has Jesus telling us to be ready in every aspect of our lives.

This new Church year gives us an added opportunity to move past the oppression experienced from the Sex Abuse Scandal we have been facing. It gives us an opportunity to rebuild our faith in the Church and carry out its Divine Mission. This does not mean we forget the pain the abuse has caused for so many victims and their family and friends. Nor does it mean we do nothing to help them. It is also a time for us to make sure this does not happen again and we all seek the necessary reforms needed to ensure that. We cannot do this on our own we must invoke the grace and power of the Holy Spirit to help us to be

a people of hope and salvation. This is an opportunity for us to be empowered to make a difference, and if we can do this, the New Year becomes all that it is supposed to be. As we light the First Advent Candle, we begin our journey not only to Christmas, but also to Easter, Pentecost, and beyond.

Today at 3PM, we will have our Fall Anointing of the Sick Mass. This is a good way to start the year if you or a loved one is in need of this special sacrament to seek Christ's healing power for soul, mind and body. Other Advent opportunities for prayer and celebration will be found in the bulletin, please consult our Advent Calendar. Next Sunday night December 8, we will observe the National Night of Prayer to pray for the end of Abortion and the taking of all Innocent Life. We will start at 9PM Sunday Night and conclude at 1AM Monday Morning. We will pray each hour before the exposed Blessed Sacrament and we will pray the Rosary and other prayers. Please join us for one or more of these hours.

"You come in peace and meekness, and lowly will your cradle be; all clothed in human weakness shall we your Godhead see. Dear Savior haste; come, come to earth, dispel the night and show your face, and bid us hail the dawn of grace. O Come Divine Messiah!
