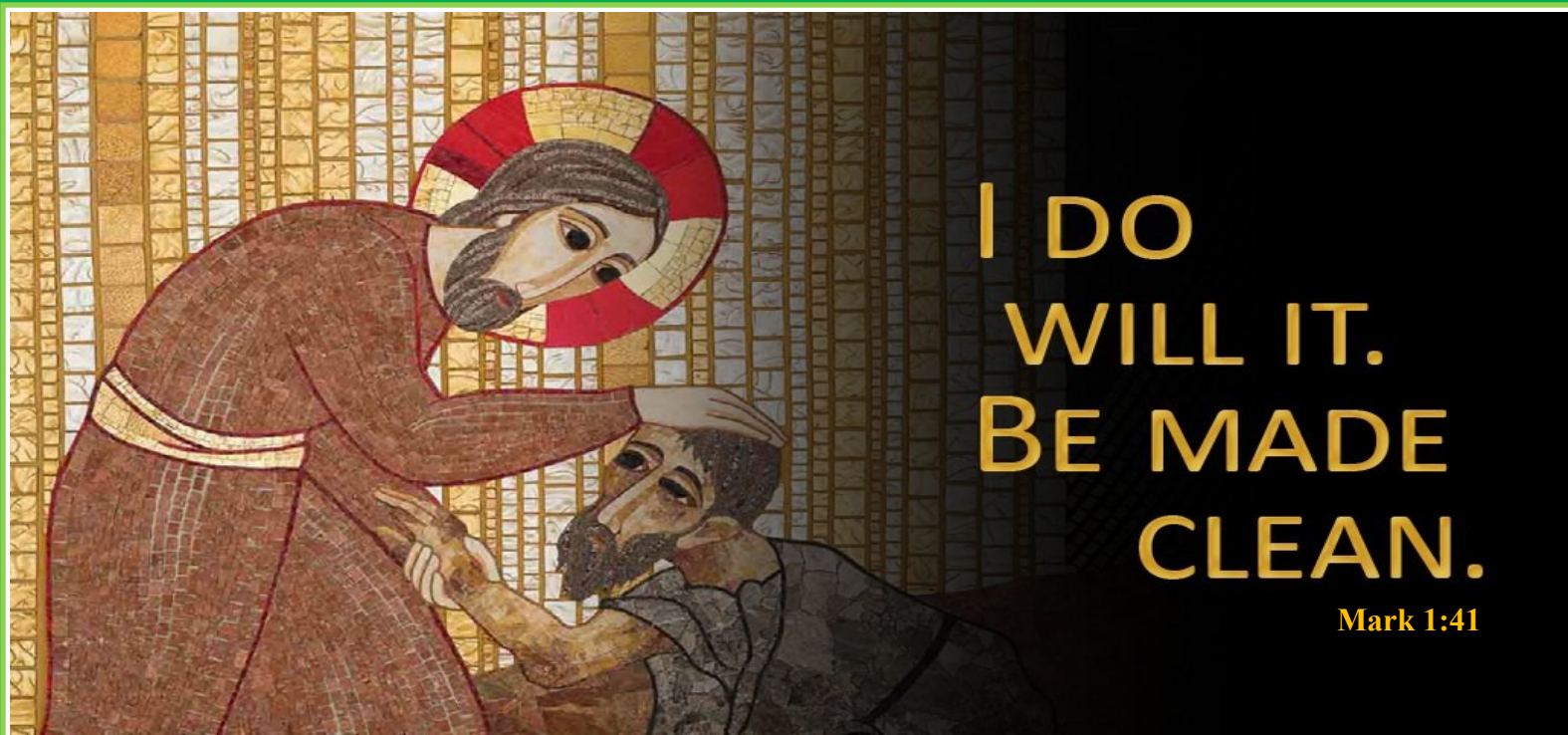

From Fr. Mike's Desk

In today's world when a person is suffering from a serious disease or has been exposed to a person who is infected, we place that person under quarantine. We all know what that feels like! We of course do this so no one else will catch the disease and to avoid an epidemic. As today's first reading and the Gospel tell us, this isolation requirement was in place in ancient Israel, especially when it came to leprosy or any other skin ailment. However, the rule to separate the person from the community had more of an effect than just preventing the spread of disease. The Mosaic Law also declared that the infected person was also spiritually unclean and could no longer be a part of the community's worship of God. They were cut off from all normal life, physically and spiritually. The Law made sure that it separated the person from everyone else by requiring the person with leprosy to shout out, "Unclean, unclean!"

This was the Law for centuries even during the time of Jesus. So, when we read in the Gospel how the leper came to Jesus, and asked for a cure, we realize that the leper was violating the Law and there could have been repercussions. However, he was not the only lawbreaker. For Jesus moved with pity stretched out His hand, touched him, and said, "***I do will it. Be made clean.***" Our Lord breaks this law so that He can make the man whole and restore his relationship with his family, friends, and most importantly with God so he can rejoin the faith community. This could only happen if the man followed Jesus' command to show himself to the priest and offer up the cleansing that Moses prescribed.

The leper had a direct encounter with Christ and as a result, was cured, and was able to return to full life. We must remember that such encounters with the Lord are not restricted to the Gospel or Old Testament figures. We too can have an encounter with Christ in a way that is far better than the leper or anyone else in the Gospel. Certainly, his cure was a miracle, but in many ways, this was just a one-time encounter and one that was alive only in memory. Our encounters with Christ come every day as we pray, read Scripture, attend Sunday and Weekday Mass, and receive the Sacraments. The Sacraments are a direct encounter with the Risen Lord, and they are a regular part of our lives as we live them out on this side of God's Kingdom.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the Sacraments as powers that come forth from the Body of Christ, which is ever-living and life-giving. They are actions of the Holy Spirit at work in His Body the Church. The Sacraments are efficacious signs of grace instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church by which the Divine Life is dispensed to us. The visible rites by which we celebrate the Sacraments signify and make present the graces proper to each. The Seven Sacraments touch all the important moments of our Christian life; they give birth, and they increase healing and faith. There is a certain resemblance between the stages of natural life and the stages of spiritual life. The Seven sacraments are divided into three groups. The Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist; the Sacraments of Healing: Penance and Anointing of the Sick; and the Sacraments of Vocation: Marriage and Holy Orders. Thus, Christ is with us not only in our memories but also in our regular encounters of the Word and Sacraments.

This coming Wednesday we enter Lent and our own desert experience of forty days and nights. During this period we are to prepare ourselves to fully accept the life-transforming events of the Life, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus which we will fully celebrate at the end of this time. As Jesus fought off the perils of the desert so should we use this time to fight off the perils of temptation and sin. Ash Wednesday is a solemn day of fasting and abstaining from meat. It is a day we mark our foreheads with ashes from last year's Palm Sunday. Unfortunately, it is also Valentine's Day, so I guess it will have to be shrimp or lobster for dinner. I do not think it will be wrong if you have some chocolate. Please consult the bulletin for all the different prayer opportunities offered during this Holy Season of Lent.

Please remember and pray about supporting the Catholic Ministries Appeal. Please remember the Catholic Ministries Appeal and the help that it offers so many people in our Diocese and even here in St. Edward's. Once again, our goal for this year is \$112,100. The Pope at Audience

At the weekly General Audience this past Wednesday, Pope Francis reflects on sadness and invites us to take comfort in Jesus' Resurrection, saying He can comfort our despair and sense of loss if we respond with faith in God's goodness. When overwhelmed by sadness, take comfort in Jesus' Resurrection. Continuing his catechesis series on virtues and vices, the Pope focused this week on the sin of excessive sadness (*acedia vel tristitia*, in Latin), recalling that there are two types of sadness. The first, he explained, is "a sorrow that is appropriate to Christian life, and that with God's grace can be changed into joy." This form of sorrow, he said, "must not be rejected and forms part of the path of conversion. Whereas the second kind of sadness, he said, "must be fought resolutely and with every strength, because it comes from the evil one." This "ailment of the soul," he said, "arises in the human heart when a desire or hope vanishes," and was the experience of the disciples of Emmaus in St. Luke's Gospel of Luke, as they lamented Jesus' loss. "We all go through ordeals that generate sorrow in us, because life makes us conceive dreams that are then shattered," the Pope acknowledged, pointing out that after our internal turmoil, some people are unable to get beyond melancholy and sadness, whereas others are able to be regenerated in hope. When overwhelmed by sadness, take comfort in Jesus' Resurrection.

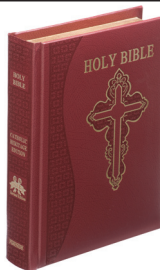
