From Fr. Mike's Desk

About three months ago, I attended the Funeral Mass for my classmate Father Martin Klein. On May 25, 1991, nine of us were ordained priests for the Diocese of Rockville Centre. During the years, four members left ministry, leaving five of us to carry on with the mission. Now with Fr. Klein returning to God, that leaves only four of us. You may have noticed Fr. Marty's last name. Normally his name would be associated with a Jewish person and in this case, it was. If you have not already guessed, Fr. Marty became a Catholic Christian in the early 1980's. Delivering the homily at the Mass was his very good friend and adopted brother, Msgr. Thom Costa, who is the director of the Pius X Home for Retired Clergy. Msgr. Costa explained that Fr. Marty would tell people he converted for one very simple reason. He fell in love with Jesus Christ. According Msgr. Costa Fr. Marty loved the passage from John's Gospel, "**For God so loved the world that He sent His only Son...**" This passage allowed him to focus on God's plan for salvation; one could say that he was transformed by Christ. More than being transformed, Fr. Marty was transfigured for he saw God in a new way, that allowed him to say that he was still Jewish, but now he was a complete Jew. He found Christ and became one with Christ as we all do through Baptism. While his transfiguration may not be visible to others (as Jesus appeared in today's Gospel) it was manifested by Fr. Marty's actions and his dedicated service to God and the Church for almost 29 years.

When Peter, James and John saw the Transfigured Jesus they were seeing Him in a way they never saw Him before. They saw Him in a way that showed His true Divine Nature. While they did not totally understand the nature of the Incarnation of the Son of God, they now knew that there was more to Jesus than met the eye. We, too, can see more to Jesus when we look at Him through the eyes of faith. Like the Apostles we can say, "Lord it is good for us to be here", not to try to capture the moment, but to allow it to capture us and change us. How can we do this, if it did not totally change the Apostles who were there? Well it did change them, but not right at that moment. They were changed after they saw the Risen Lord on Easter Sunday. When Jesus appeared to them exactly the way He did on the mountain. They were changed when they received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, just as we were

through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. We also change every time we receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Remember, when we receive the Eucharist we are totally receiving the Body, Blood, Soul, Humanity and Divinity of Jesus. This is why the Eucharist is also called the True or Real Presence. **It is not a symbol or just a reminder of Jesus, it truly is Jesus. Jesus, coming to us in a Sacramental Form. So many people (even Catholics) do not understand this. We must go out and help them!** We can do this when we allow ourselves to be transfigured, we can do this, when we like Fr. Marty, fall deeply in love with Jesus.

We close with the following prayer: O God, who in the glorious Transfiguration of your Only Begotten Son confirmed the mysteries of faith by the witness of the Fathers and wonderfully prefigured our full adoption as your children, grant to your servants that listening to the voice of your beloved Son, we may merit to become co-heirs with Him, Who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever.
Amen

In The Pope’s Words

In his homily last Thursday Pope Francis said that the Gospel teaches us the **three steps** that help us learn who Jesus truly is. The **first step** is to know Jesus and, and we do this when “when we read the Gospel, when we take children to catechesis... to Mass”. The **second step** is witnessing to Jesus, and for this we need the power of God and the Holy Spirit, to say that He is God, that He is the Son of God”. The **third step** is accepting Jesus’ death, to which the Pope added that Jesus began to teach His apostles that He had to suffer, be killed and then rise again to fulfill his purpose.

Directives and Guidelines for Parishes for Health Considerations during Virus Seasons from the Office of the Chancellor Announcements

As a health precaution, the Diocese of Rockville Centre instructs all Pastors, Clergy and Parish Churches to enact the following measures immediately:

1. Until further notice, **the Precious Blood of Christ (the Chalice) is not to be distributed to anyone other than clergy (priests / deacons) or those who for health reasons must only receive the Precious Blood.**
2. Until further notice, **the Sign of Peace will not be given / exchanged in any form** during Holy Mass.
3. The following practices are encouraged in all parishes:
 - a. Parishioners are instructed to remain at home if they are sick. This includes deacons, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, lectors, altar servers, ushers, music ministers, etc.. Those who are able to attend Mass should be encouraged to wash and sanitize their hands.
 - b. Priests, deacons, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion and altar servers should wash their hands immediately before serving. Disinfectant soap and/or hand sanitizer should be provided for them. Clergy and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are encouraged to wash / disinfect their hands after serving as well.
 - c. Holy water fonts at the doors of the church should be emptied and cleaned several times per week, especially before and after weekends.
 - d. Parishioners who prefer to receive Holy Communion on the tongue still have that right, though they may freely choose to receive the Sacred Host in their hands during this precautionary time. (See *Redemptionis Sacramentum*, no. 92)
 - e. Cleaning and disinfecting practices normally carried out in our churches and parish facilities should be given extra and careful attention during this time.
 - f. Clergy may wish to discontinue the practice of shaking hands if greeting parishioners after Mass.

LENTEN RULES - FASTING & ABSTINENCE

LENT

Pray + Fast + Give

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Roman Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Roman Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

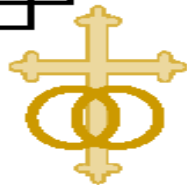

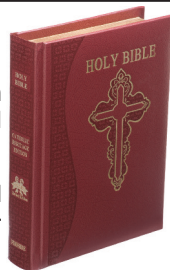
