

## From Fr. Mike's Desk

Many homeowners on Long Island, in fact in any suburban areas, love to plant vegetable gardens. For the local gardener there is nothing like homegrown produce right from the back yard. There are, of course, great advantages to having your own garden. One, is you know exactly how the plants were grown and taken care of, and the other is you save money on food, and nothing beats fresh fruits and vegetables. My brother Joe used to plant a garden every year at our home in Lindenhurst. He would plant a variety of vegetables and he would exercise great care with the plants. One year he tried to grow potatoes, perfect for our Long Island soil. He certainly made his best effort, but at harvest time, when he dug up the plants the potatoes were small. They were the size of stones, but he was excited, and he was going to cook them. After they were cooked, he realized that two of the potatoes were stones, and we never let him forget about it.

Nevertheless, he still pushed on, and it was the great mystery of life that surrounded the planting of seeds, or a little plant and watching it grow that captured the imagination. When we look at this life, it makes perfect sense that everything starts out small and in time grows and gets stronger, and produces fruit. Just look at ourselves. This is true of all physical life, but it is also true of our spiritual life. Our relationship with God starts out as a small seed (receiving the Holy Spirit at Baptism) and our faith grows and grows, as we get older and hopefully wiser.

Our readings today from the Book of the Prophet Ezekiel and the Gospel of Mark speak about God's spirit growing inside us as time progresses. Ezekiel tells us that God will take off the top of a cedar tree, tear off its tender shoots, and plant it on a high and lofty mountain. It will put forth branches, bear much fruit, and become a majestic cedar. This of course foreshadows what Jesus tells us in Mark's Gospel. Our Lord uses parables to describe the Kingdom of God, and he uses the example of the Sower and the seed. He tells us the farmer spreads the seed even though he does not know how it grows. As the seed grows, it turns into a blade and then an ear, and then to a full number of kernels of grain in the ear. Likewise, we see the example of the mustard seed, which is so small and grows to become one of the larger bushes. So, it is with us when it comes to our understanding of the Kingdom. The Kingdom's seeds are planted inside of us, again at Baptism, and they grow as we approach receiving the Eucharist and Confirmation. From there,

they grow further as we approach our vocation to Religious Life, Ordained Ministry, or Marriage, or as a dedicated single person. Sometimes our understanding is small, but if we allow the Holy Spirit to be in our hearts (as we saw last week), then what is small will grow and bear much fruit.

Today is also Father's Day and if you wish to have your fathers, living or deceased, remembered in the Father's Day Novena, please write their names on the envelopes in your packets or that can be found in the Church and place them in the collection basket or drop them off at the Rectory.

We wish all our Fathers, Grandfathers, and all who have been like Fathers to us a Happy and Holy Father's Day

## Pope at Audience

During his weekly General Audience this past Wednesday Pope Francis reflected on the work of the Holy Spirit in revelation, highlighting His role in inspiring and explaining Sacred Scripture.

The Holy Spirit not only inspires Sacred Scripture, but also "makes them inspiring." However, the work of the Holy Spirit does not end with inspiration, Pope Francis explained. The Holy Spirit is continually at work in the Church to explain the meaning of Scripture and make the sacred writings "perennially living and active." He gave the example of being inspired by a passage of Scripture that perhaps we have read many times "without emotion." "One day we read it in an atmosphere of faith and prayer," the Pope said, and "the text is unexpectedly illuminated" by the Holy Spirit. And he prayed, "May the Holy Spirit, who inspired the Scriptures and now breathes with them, help us to grasp this love of God in the concrete situations of our life."




