

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Andy Warhol coined the expression, that everyone will have their fifteen minutes of fame. The full statement was made in 1968 when he said, "In the future, everyone will be world-famous for fifteen minutes." This comment grew out of his interest in fame and celebrity. Warhol believed that the media could enable any person to become famous or infamous. He was correct, especially in today's world, when people become instantly famous with the paparazzi, newspaper articles, entertainment and magazine TV programs, and all types of social media that reveal the most private details about a person's People love celebrities and are very life. conscious about the people who take the walk of fame. However, we also know that for some, fame's fifteen minutes is all they really seem to get, and as quickly as they became a sensation, they have now become a non-entity.

Jesus was an object of peoples' curiosity in His day. Many people followed Him from place to place to see Him, hear His words, and even experience a miracle or two. It seemed that they could not get enough of Jesus, and this included the Apostles as well. Yet the Apostles had more than a curiosity and more than a passing fancy in and with Jesus. But like the fame seekers they too did not fully understand everything about Him. That is why they are frightened while on the Sea of Galilee when the storm starts. Yes, they believe they could drown, and that is why they questioned Jesus about His lack of concern. But if they realized who He truly was, they would not have been frightened. Jesus challenges them about their lack of faith, and He calls them and us to see that the Son of God is more than a curiosity.

Jesus calls them to cast off all fear and to trust and believe in God through His only Son. For the Son came into the world to save it, and the Apostles cannot be like everyone else. No, they must have more than a passing interest in Jesus, and so should we! Well certainly we do, or we would not be here, but there are times when we are afraid and do not trust. There are times we do not share our faith with others or go beyond doing the bare minimum. Just as Jesus calmed the sea, so can he calm each of our fears and spur us on to do more in His Holy Name.
