From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today is indeed the Feast Day of the Holy Spirit, therefore, today's letter for this Pentecost Sunday concerns itself with the Holy Spirit. We will try to understand who the Holy Spirit is. What does the Holy Spirit do! In addition, how has the Church come to know about the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. Today's material for this letter, comes from the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and can be found starting with #683 (page 179 from the hard cover edition). As we begin, we see the quote from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. "No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit" "God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, saying 'Abba!' 'Father.'" This knowledge of faith is possible only through the Holy Spirit, for to be touched by Christ, the Holy Spirit must first touch us. The Spirit comes to meet us and kindles faith within us, by virtue of our Baptism. The Holy Spirit in the Church commends to us personally the life that originates with the Father, and offered to us through the Son. For those who hear God's Spirit are lead to the Word who is the Son, and the Son presents them to the Father. No one can approach the Father without the Son, for we receive the knowledge of the Father through the Son, and again no one can come to the Son without the Holy Spirit.

Through His grace, the Holy Spirit is the first to awaken faith within us. However, the Spirit is the last of the Divine Persons revealed. St. Nazianzus Gregory of explains that as condescension. The Old Testament showed us the Father clearly, but the Son obscurely. The New Testament revealed the Son clearly and gave us a glimpse of the divinity of the Spirit. Now the Spirit dwells among us and gives us a clear vision of Himself. The Spirit reveals itself through His communion with the Church. No one can comprehend the thoughts of God except by the Spirit of God. The Spirit does not speak of Himself, no, the Spirit who has spoken through the Prophets, makes us hear the Father's Word; He will not speak of Himself but He will speak of Christ. We see the Holy Spirit working in the Church through her Traditions, the teachings of the Church Fathers, the assistance given to the Magisterium, in His working in the Liturgy and the Sacraments, and in our individual and communal prayers. We see it in the various gifts and ministries by which the Church is built up, in the witness of the Apostolic and Missionary life, and in the virtues and lives of the Saints.

The Catechism reminds us that when the Father sends His Word, He also sends His Breath. In their joint mission, the Son and the Spirit, both Persons are distinct, but they are also inseparable. In short, it is Christ who is seen, the visible image of the invisible God, but it is the Holy Spirit who reveals Christ. As we continue, we are also to understand that when Christ is fully glorified, He can in turn send the Holy Spirit from His place with the Father to those who believe in Him. Now the joint mission of the Son and the Spirit is made manifest in the children adopted by the Father in the Body of His Son. The Spirit is to unite the children to Christ and make them live in Him. On the day of the first Pentecost (as we celebrate today) when the seven weeks of Easter has ended, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of (manifested, the Holy Spirit given and communicated as a Divine Person), and the Trinity is fully revealed. By His coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the "Last Days", the time of the Church, the Kingdom already here, but not complete. The Holy Spirit is God's gift to the Human race. God who is love has poured out His love more fully by the power of the Holy Spirit. God has freed us by the death of sin and restored us to full life. Also by His power, God's children can bear much fruit and the fruits of the Spirit can be seen in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

The mission of Christ and the Holy Spirit is brought to completion in the Church, which is the Body of Christ and the Temple of the Holy Spirit. The Church's mission is not an addition to the joint mission; no, it is a vital part of it. There is so much more to say, but we do not have enough time or space. The Holy Spirit comes to the Church on that first Pentecost and every day since, so we can do our part. That is why it is called the Birthday of the Church, because with the Spirit, Power and Grace, we can go out and make disciples of all nations.

The Third Pillar of Christian Stewardship: Formation

Imagine a mother being in the hospital as her child is born. She holds the baby for the first time, falls deeply in love and says "I am a mother." After she says those words, she gets up and disappears, never seeing her child again and never loving the child.



Now, think of someone who has just come to the Faith. They have gone through RCIA, were baptized at the Easter Vigil Mass and then proceeded to go out and live an un-Christian life. There is a comparison between these two stories that teach us that to truly be something, you must live it. Being a Christian is in no way different. We need to be constantly forming our faith. We cannot become stagnant. Think of the Sacraments as workouts and our spirit as our body. The more we go to Mass, the more we go to confession, the more we adore Christ in Adoration... the more we grow as Christians.




