Reading 1 - Jeremiah 23:1-6

Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock of my pasture, says the LORD. Therefore, thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, against the shepherds who shepherd my people: You have scattered my sheep and driven them away. You have not cared for them, but I will take care to punish your evil deeds. I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands to which I have driven them and bring them back to their meadow; there they shall increase and multiply. I will appoint shepherds for them who will shepherd them so that they need no longer fear and tremble; and none shall be missing, says the LORD.

Reading 2 – Ephesians 2:13-18

Brothers and sisters:
In Christ Jesus you who once were far off have become near by the blood of Christ.

For he is our peace, he who made both one and broke down the dividing wall of enmity, through his flesh, abolishing the law with its commandments and legal claims, that he might create in himself one new person in place of the two, thus establishing peace, and might reconcile both with God, in one body, through the cross, putting that enmity to death by it. He came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near, for through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

Gospel – Mark 6:30-34

The apostles gathered together with Jesus and reported all they had done and taught. He said to them, “*Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while.*” People were coming and going in great numbers, and they had no opportunity even to eat. So they went off in the boat by themselves to a deserted place. People saw them leaving and many came to know about it. They hastened there on foot from all the towns and arrived at the place before them.

When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

From Fr. Mike's Desk

This week's Gospel reading continues where last week's left off. If you will recall, Jesus sends the Apostles out two by two to preach the Good News, and He gives them a share in His power and authority to cast out demons and heal the sick. He gives this very same power to His Church as Jesus ascended into Heaven. In fact, last week's Gospel Passage shows Jesus' plan for what the Church is to do long before the events, which took place on the first Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday.

In this week's account, the Apostles have come back, and they were very tired, yet they were also very excited. They cannot wait to get back to Jesus and tell Him all that they did. Likewise, Jesus is excited to hear all they did in His name. Tell me all about it, Jesus said to them and let us go off to a place where we can be alone and rest. However, as the Gospel hints, the Apostles were so successful, that more people came to believe in Jesus and wanted more than just hearing about Him, they wanted to see Him. Picture the mixed emotions that Jesus experienced, for He wanted to go off with the Apostles, but He could not leave the people, for they were like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus is surely the shepherd that Jeremiah spoke about in our first reading. Jesus does what any good shepherd would do He cares for the sheep. Remember if our Lord did that for people 2021 years ago; think about how much He does from us from His place in heaven. Think of how much more Jesus cares for His sheep through His living body the Church and through the shepherds He appoints over His Church. Keep in mind that we are all to shepherd and care for one another.

Remember the 2021 Catholic Ministry Appeal we still have to raise more to meet our goal of \$105,500. When we meet our goal, we will receive a rebate over \$25,000, which will allow St. Edward's to be shepherd to the people of Syosset. There is still time to donate to this very worthwhile appeal.

Attune our minds to the sound of His voice and lead our steps in the path He has shown. We ask this in the name of Jesus the Good Shepherd. Amen.

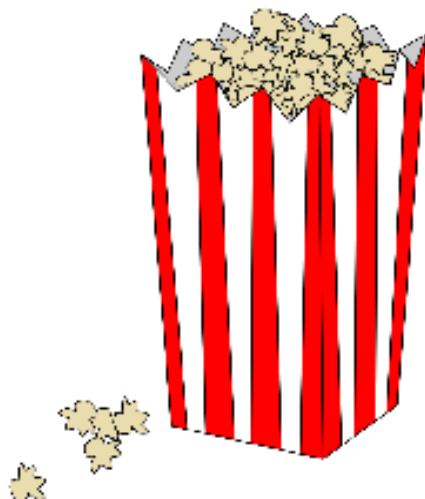

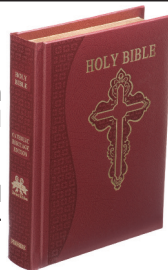
