## From Fr. Mike's Desk

This year, from the First Sunday of Advent to the Feast of Christ the King, we have been in Lectionary Cycle B, which features the Gospel According to St. Mark. If you have noticed, Mark's Gospel is the shortest and presents the Liturgists with the problem of how we spread it out to cover the complete Liturgical year. When the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council compiled the Lectionary, they were unsure how to answer this question. They also were questioning how the Liturgy would manage the reading of John's Gospel. They debated as to whether to give John his own cycle year, but how would that solve the problem of the shortness of Mark's Gospel? They decided not to give John his own year, but to insert the Fourth Gospel every year during the Easter Season and to have it read during the summer months of Mark's Cycle. In this way, we proclaim all four gospels at Sunday Mass. This Sunday, we begin hearing from John with the account of the Bread of Life Discourse, following the Miracle of the Loaves and Fish.

We have heard the account of this miracle several times, but on this 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time, a reading from the Second Book of Kings precedes the Gospel. That reading tells us how the Prophet Elisha fed one hundred people with only twenty loaves. Like Jesus, Elisha must feed a considerable number of people with what surely was not enough. Yet, the Prophet's belief and trust in God allows him to accomplish such a great feat. Not only was there enough food but there were also leftovers. Jesus of course feeds over five thousand with far less, only five loaves and two fish. This shows a far greater power is at work, and this is true for someone far greater is conducting the miracle. Furthermore, Jesus performs this miracle under His power (unlike saints and prophets who must invoke the power of God through intercessions). The Gospel tells us, that after Jesus fed the great crowd, the people wanted to make Him king. Why, because Jesus reminded them of the tradition that the Messiah would feed the people like Moses did during the Exodus. Thus, they declared Him king, and with that, our Lord ran away! Jesus does not accept their crown for that would be allowing humans to decide the Messiah's mission. They wanted Jesus to be a king of a political nature, wanted Him to be a rival to Rome, and even defeat Rome. He is the Messiah, He has the power of miracles, and He can use it to stop Rome! Jesus had no intention of setting up a political kingdom; all He wanted was to establish the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom whose only concern is the forgiveness of sins and eternal life. We see this, if we look at the miracle, and all Jesus did through spiritual eyes.

As I am sure, you have heard many times, this miracle represents the Eucharist in John's Gospel, and it prefigures how Jesus will feed us constantly with His Body and Blood. The crowd was huge and remarkably diverse, with people from every lifestyle, and Christ called them all to Himself. Christ calls the very same people, all of us, every day and

He feeds us with His Body and Blood. This reminds us of the other Spiritual Meaning behind this miracle. Remember, that in Jesus' time (and even today) when one shared a meal with a person or a group this meant you shared life with that person. Likewise, they shared in your life. That is why the leadership got upset when Jesus ate with sinners and tax collectors. When Jesus invites us to share in this Sacred Meal, **He is inviting us to share His life**, He is sharing with us the forgiveness of sins, the love of The Father, the Grace of the Holy Spirit, and the gift of Eternal Life. Jesus, because of His great love and generosity, gives us the ability to extend the invitation to others. He urges us to invite them to the Feast of Heaven and Earth, to come to the Table of Plenty, where God will provide for all our needs.

# **Help Save Lives Today!**

The St. Edward's Blood Drive is this Sunday, July 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:15 AM to 12:45 PM in the Holy Family Room.

Step up, be a HERO and donate. Each donated pint can save up to three (3) people.

Reservations are not required, just show up beginning at 8:15 AM, or later in the day. To reduce your waiting time, book a time slot in advance that suits your schedule.

You may ask, why should I donate? Here are 10 things to know:

- 1. One donation can save up to three lives.
- 2. The average adult has 10 pints of blood. Roughly 1 pint is given during a donation.
- 3. A single car accident can require as many as 100 pints of blood.
- 4. Only 9% of people in the U.S. have the universal blood type O-negative, which is needed in emergencies when responders must act before a patients' blood can be typed.
- 5. Donors can give whole blood or opt to use a process called apheresis to donate specific blood components such as red cells, plasma, or platelets.
- 6. Donated platelets must be used within 5 days of collection, so new donations are constantly needed.
- 7. The body will replenish the elements given during a blood donation in times ranging from a few hours to a couple of weeks.
- 8. All donated blood is tested for HIV, hepatitis B and C, syphilis, and other infectious diseases before it can be released to hospitals.
- 9. If you donated blood every 56 days from the time you were 17 years old until you reached the age of 76, you would have donated 48 gallons of blood, potentially helping save more than 1,000 lives.
- 10. Blood donation as a volunteer opportunity is a simple four-step process: registration, medical history/mini-physical, donation, and refreshments. The entire process takes approximately 10–12 minutes.


