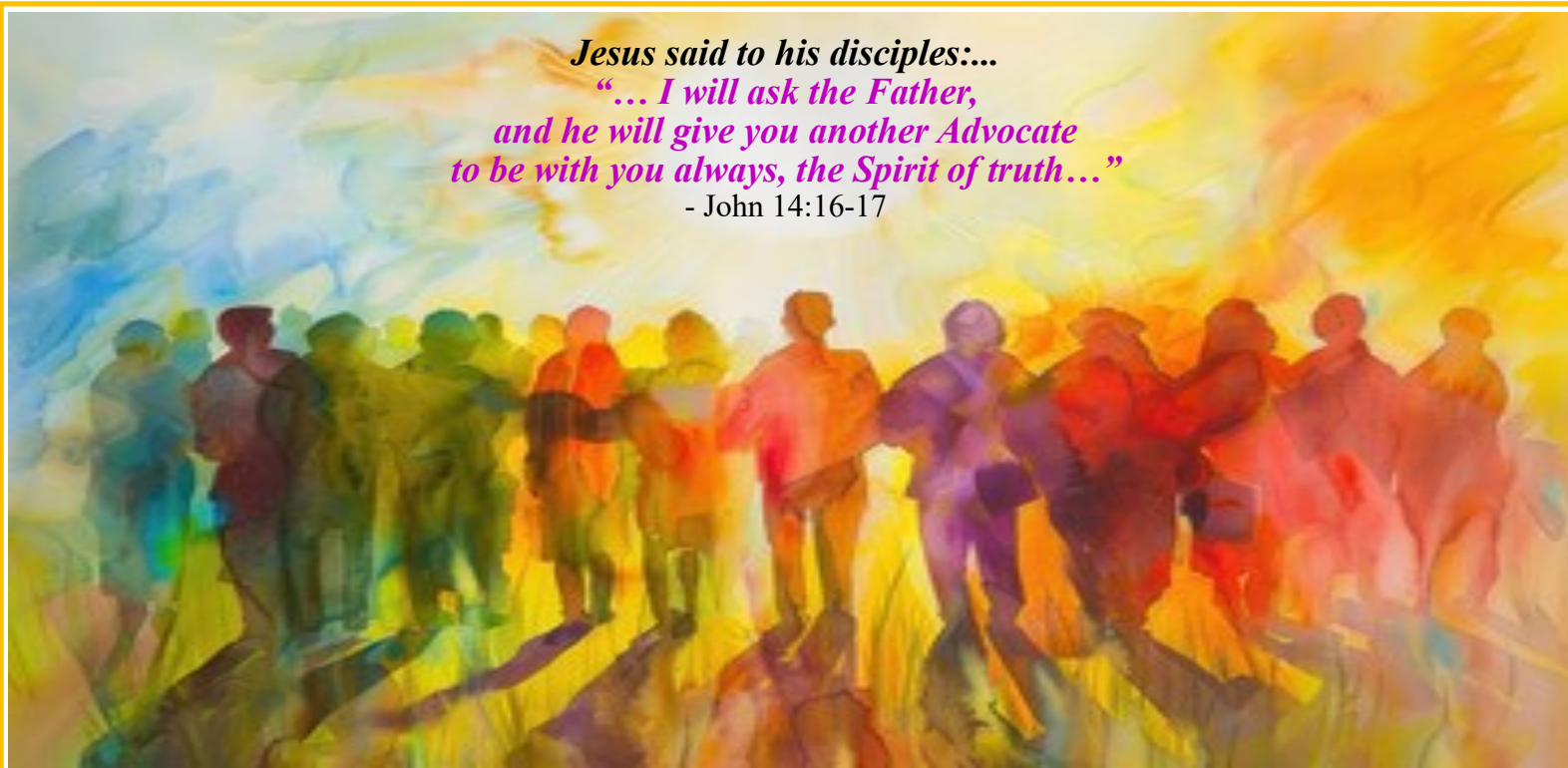

## From Fr. Mike's Desk

This week we are contemplating two major events in our Salvation History: one which we will celebrate this coming Thursday with *the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven*, and the other which is anticipated in today's readings, *the Coming of the Holy Spirit*. As we saw in last week's Gospel, the Apostles were upset about Jesus' departure from this life, and they refused to see who Jesus truly is. This is seen when Phillip asks Jesus to show them the Father, and that will be enough. Phillip probably makes this statement because he wants some reassurance that all will be ok, for if Jesus had to leave them, the Father (by His appearance at Jesus' request) would comfort them and protect them. Jesus corrects them and comforts them at the same time by telling them that when they see Him, they see the Father, for the Father and the Son are One! He tells them that He will not leave them orphans, for God will send another Advocate who is the Spirit of Truth, whom non-believers will not be able to accept, and believers will not need explanations to accept.

This Advocate is none other than God the Holy Spirit, and through the Spirit, we know that God is always with us, which is the cause of all Hope and Joy. Even when we feel or think that we are alone, The Holy Spirit is there to strengthen and guide us. All we have to do is accept God's help and be open to His presence in our lives. That is why Jesus, as He is ascending into Heaven, tells His disciples not to leave Jerusalem until they receive the Holy Spirit. One that day when He came, they were no longer afraid, and they went out to preach the Gospel to all nations.

Remember, on Thursday, we are not coming to the end of the story, just a new chapter in the story of our salvation. The chapter dealing with Christ's earthly ministry is coming to an end, and it is being followed by a new chapter in which His ministry is being carried out by the Church (you and me), the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit.

**Please keep in mind that Ascension Thursday is a Holy Day of Obligation, and as Catholics, we are to mark this day by coming together to celebrate the Eucharist. Our Masses will be Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM, Thursday, May 21<sup>st</sup> at 9:00 AM, 12:10 PM, and 7:00 PM.**

*Let us close with this Mother's Day poem  
written by Jill Lemming*

*There is no love like a mother's love, no stronger bond on earth...like the precious bond that comes from God. A mother's love is forever and strong, never changing for all times...and when her children need her most, a mother's love will shine. God bless these special mothers. God bless them everyone, for all the tears and heartache, and for the special work they've done. When her days on earth are over, a mother's love lives on...through many generations with God's blessing on each one. Be thankful for our mothers. For they love... from the power God has given and the strength from above.*

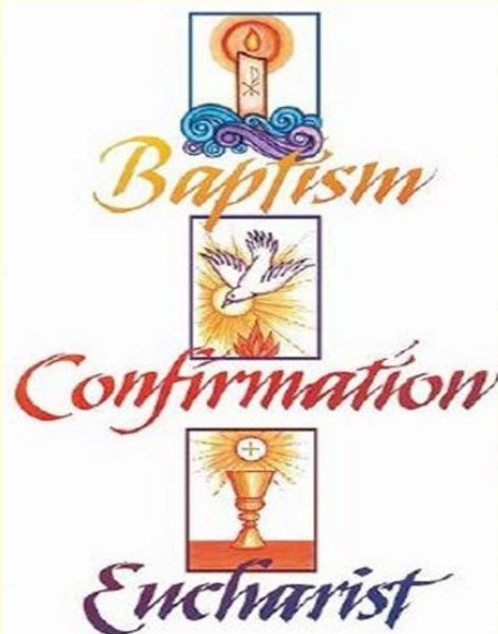

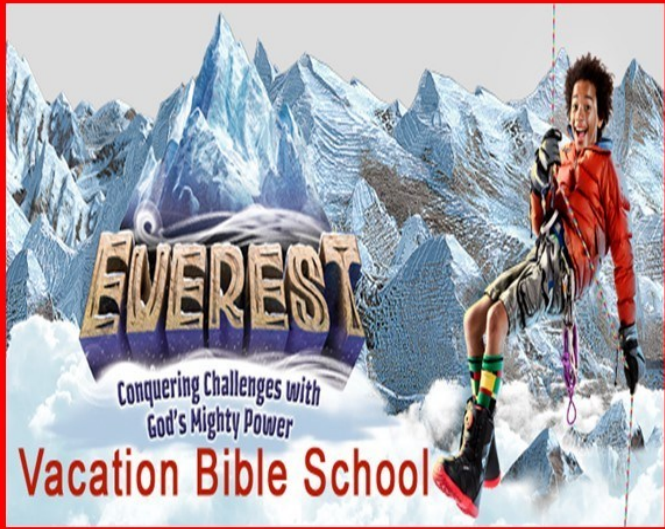

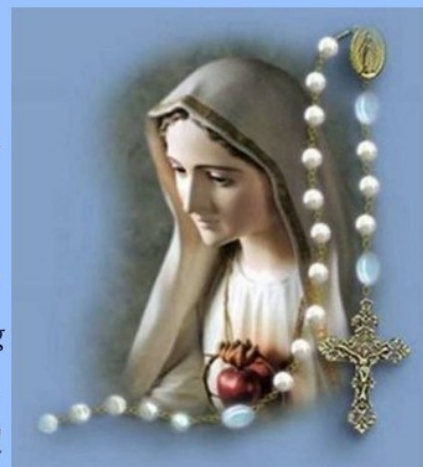


# *May is the Month for Our Lady - Family Marian Activities*

On this Mothers' Day, come join with your parish family, as we gather to crown Mary, our Mother, Queen of Heaven and of our Hearts.





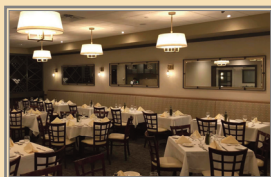

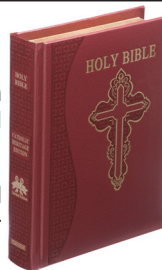
