

From Fr. Mike's Desk

What if you were at a party and found out that one of the invited guests was Jesus. What would you say to Him, what questions would you ask Him? This was the situation people found themselves in some two thousand years ago. When Jesus went to a person's house, many people came to hear Him speak, and as we see in today's Gospel, people asked Him about many things. In today's account, the questions revolve around how one could obtain eternal life. We also see that there is a question about which is the greatest commandment. The answer that Jesus gives to both types of questions is similar. His answer is to love God with all your heart, being, strength, and mind, and to love your neighbor as yourself.

Jesus gives this answer to the lawyer in today's Gospel as he asks these questions, and while for many, Jesus' answer would be enough. But this is not the case for the lawyer. As Luke tells us, he wished to justify himself with the additional question, "Who is my neighbor?" To this question. Our Lord gives a more involved answer; He gave him the Parable of the Good Samaritan! With this answer, Jesus clearly identifies who the man's neighbor is, and criticizes some of the practices of the Jewish Cult.

We must remember that for the lawyer, the scribe, and the Pharisee, the definition of neighbor was restricted to mean a fellow Jew. The Son of God challenges this definition by His telling the story and even gets the lawyer to admit that the one who is the true neighbor was the non-Jew (the Samaritan whom the Jews detested, and who equally detested the Jews). The definition of neighbor is now extended to mean anyone in need, man or woman, gentile, or Jew. Jesus' definition also expands the idea to mean the one who responds to a person in need. Jesus in this story also gives us a critical view of the Jewish practices in following their faith. The Priest and the Levite walk past their neighbor (a fellow Jew) because they are too closely following the Law. According to the Law, one could not touch a dead man (which they could have easily thought the man was) for they would be unclean for a period of seven days. For the Priest, that would mean that he would not be able to serve in the Temple. The Temple Liturgy meant more to him than the suffering man in need. The Levite was just like the Priest, as he had his part to play in the Liturgy. They also may have had a concern about their personal safety. This was because the Jericho Road was a place where robbers would pretend to be injured and would

then ambush anyone who stopped to help. The Levite put his personal needs over the needs of his neighbor.

This parable calls us to remember that everyone or nation who is in need is our neighbor, and our help must be as wide as the love of God. The help we offer must be practical and not consist of merely feeling sorry for those in need. I am sure that the Priest and the Levite felt some sorrow for the man; however, they still did nothing for the injured man. Jesus challenges us to act just as the Samaritan acted.



Did You Know...?

This Tuesday is the Memorial of Saint Bonaventure. Perhaps not a household name for most people, Saint Bonaventure, nevertheless, played an important role in both the medieval Church and the history of the Franciscan Order. A senior faculty member at the University of Paris, Saint Bonaventure certainly captured the hearts of his students through his academic skills and insights. But more importantly, he captured their hearts through his Franciscan love for Jesus and the Church. Like his model, Saint Francis, Jesus was the center of everything—his teaching, his administration, his writing, and his life. So much so, that he was given the title "Seraphic Doctor." Bonaventure so united holiness and theological knowledge that he rose to the heights of mysticism while remaining a very active preacher and teacher, one beloved by all who met him. To know him was to love him; to read him is still for us today to meet a true Franciscan and a gentleman.

St. Edward's Religious Education Program is an 8 year faith formation program for children attending public schools or non Catholic private schools. Religious Education Students are required to begin their religious studies in Grade 1 and complete their formal religious education classes in Grade 8.

Preparation for their reception of First Confession and First Holy Communion takes place in Grades 1 and 2. Students will receive

their First Confession in March of Grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of same year. Grades 3 - 6 are required continuation years for their studies. Confirmation studies occurs in Grades 7 and 8, with their Confirmation in the Fall of 9th Grade.

In Person Religion Classes will begin the week of September 28th.
