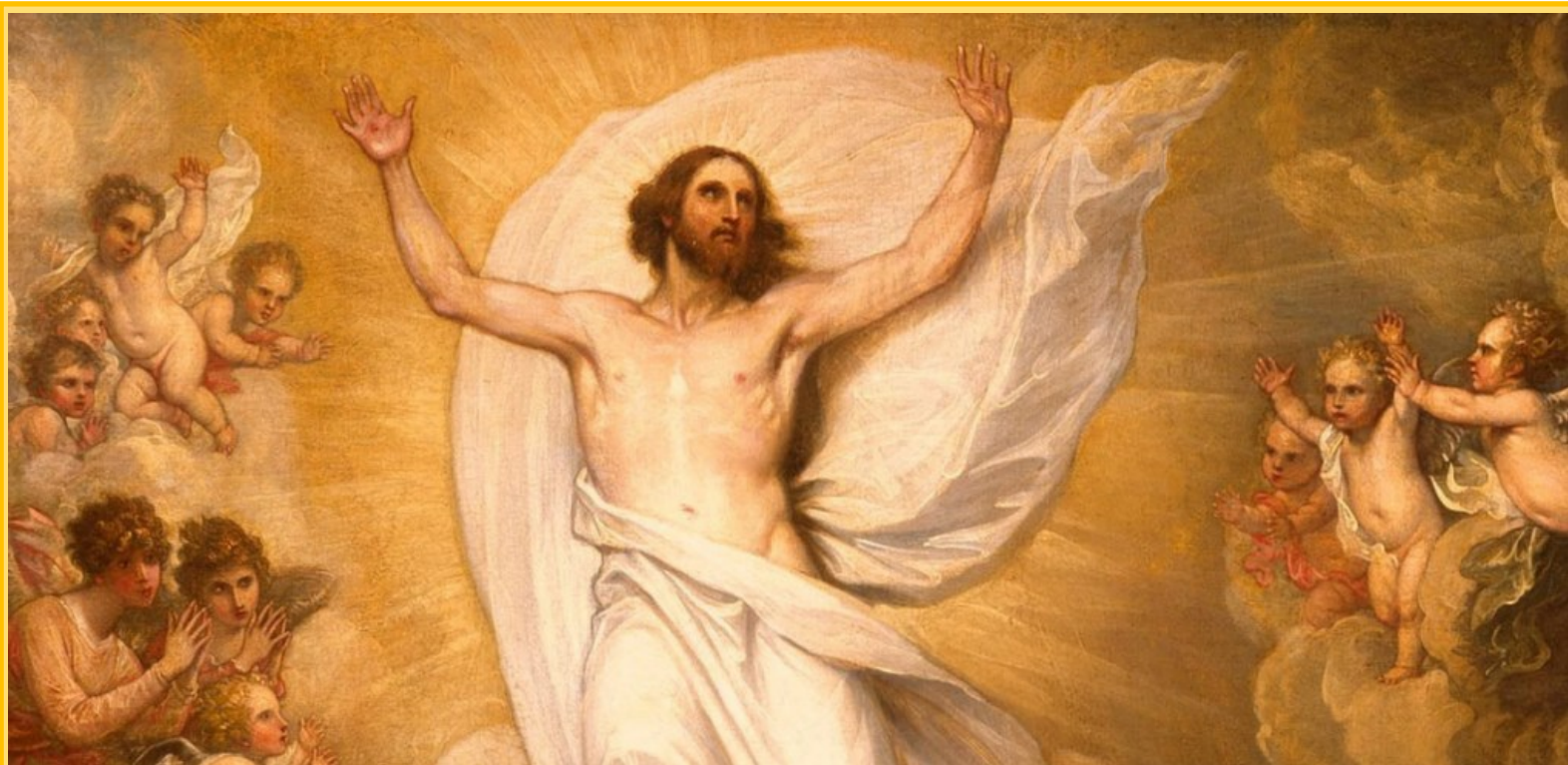

From Fr. Mike's Desk

This Seventh Sunday of Easter finds us between the Solemnity of the Ascension and Pentecost Sunday. As was mentioned last week, the Lord's Ascension shows us that the first part of Christ's Mission has come to an end, and that the second part of the Mission has begun or will begin with the coming of the Holy Spirit. At Pentecost, with the coming of the Holy Spirit, the Church now begins the second part of Christ's Mission, and this is indeed the Birthday of the Church (more on this next week).

John's Gospel today refers to the Father's Glory and tells us how Jesus shares in that Glory. We, in turn, also share in God's Glory, but in our own unique way. So, what exactly is God's Glory? Glory is defined as great praise, honor, or distinction given by common consent or renown, and it is something that provides honor, fame, or adoration for a great achievement. However, this is how human glory is defined. What about God's Glory? Glory, according to Scriptures, means more than the qualities listed above. For the Glory of God shows God's great majesty and power, manifested in the events of creation, which come about by God merely willing it into being. Divine Glory could also be understood as the Divine Order of Things.

God created the world not to increase or acquire blessedness. No, God created the world to reveal His perfection. God's Glory would be meaningless if there were not beings (the angels and us) that could see it. But God goes beyond showing us what He can do. He uses His glory to call us to a deeper relationship with Him, a relationship of true freedom and true love. Throughout the Old Testament, we see many examples of God's Glory; however, God's Glory is veiled. Remember how Moses saw God manifested in the Burning Bush, and remember how God was seen by Israel as a Pillar of Cloud by day and a Pillar of Fire at night. Even when God became one of us in the person of Jesus, the highest and greatest Divine Revelation, it was not a complete revelation. It was not complete because the glory of God was hidden in the humanity of Jesus. Yet, we can see God's Glory in Jesus' miracles, His proclaiming the Divine Will, as He announces the Good News of Salvation. Of course, the full Glory of the Son of God is hidden only for the time of His Mission here on Earth, but it is fully realized when He rises from the dead, ascends into Heaven, and sends the Holy Spirit upon the Church along with God the Father.

The great mystery of the Incarnation also reveals to us that we, too, share in God's Glory. As mentioned above, God's Glory is manifested not for His sake, but for Creation's sake, our sake. We can perceive God's Glory so that we can grow closer to God and eternal life. Naturally, when we move closer to God through Christ and the Holy Spirit, we then reflect God dwelling within us, which hopefully directs others to God. However, for us to participate in this Divine Glory, we must know Jesus, and I do not mean know about Him. After all, anybody could pick up a history or a theology text or even the Bible and gain an academic knowledge of Jesus, but this is not knowing Jesus; this is knowing about Him. To know Him, we must feel Him in our heart and soul, we must hear His voice in our daily life, and see His work in the holy actions of others. We also need the Holy Spirit, which again leads us to next week and the Great Feast of Pentecost. Do not forget to wear RED!
