From Fr. Mike's Desk

"My word shall not return to me void but shall do my will achieving the end for which I sent it."

God tells us through the Prophet Isaiah that His word is to be taken quite seriously, and that it is not uttered aimlessly. No, it is spoken with great intent and purpose, and it is so powerful that no matter what, it will achieve the goal for God, who spoke it! We see this throughout the Old Testament and in today's Gospel reading of the Parable of the Sower.

The word of God, and how we receive it, is the subject of this parable, but before we can get to this focus, let us first look at the dialogue between Jesus and the disciples as to why He teaches in parables. A parable is a story, and we love stories. We find them easier to remember than lessons learned in school. A story usually remains with us forever, and we like to share it with other people; those whom we know well or even with someone we just happen to strike up a conversation with. Stories usually have a point or help illustrate a point that they are trying to make, and Jesus' parables are no exceptions. That is what Jesus is telling the Apostles when He explains why He teaches in parables. If the listener can get the point, he or she will be able to go beyond the narration of the story and see the saving message that Jesus wishes to impart. Unfortunately, the sad fact is that not everyone can get the point or can apply the teaching to how they should live their lives. Fortunately, they are not totally left in the dark, but this does depend on the person's ability to be open to the working of the Holy Spirit in their life. For people can always change and eventually desire to follow God's call, and it is up to us to help them by explaining the story and, of course, by living it out.

Certainly, Our Lord expected the Apostles, and now His Church, to spread the word so it would come to its desired end. For the Apostles and the church were the ones meant to understand and pass on the wisdom as we see in Jesus' words, *"But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear. Amen, I say to you many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it."* Therefore, it is up to us to pass on the word, but do remember if the other person has no desire to listen or be open, then we can only do so much; it is not up to us but them, but we must try.

The ability to hear and be open is the point of the Parable of the Sower, and each time I read it, I believe that depending on the situation, I can fit into each of the categories that Jesus mentions about where the seed falls. This may apply to you, too, or someone you know. I hope that for most of my life, I am like the seed sown in the rich soil; I hear the word of God, I understand it or do my best, and then I let it take root in my heart and soul, so I can produce much fruit. However, I do know that there are times when I feel or act like the seed sown in the rocky soil.

Yes, I do hear the word, I acknowledge it with joy, but when temptation enters my life, I give in and commit sin. Yes, I dislike it when I am like that, but I do know that due to human weakness, I can be like this. With the help of God and your prayers, my brothers and sisters, I hope these times will be rare. I certainly hope I am never like the seed sown in the path, the one who refuses to understand the word of God and allows the Evil One to take me away.

With all this being said, let us pray and support one another so that we can always be rooted in the rich soil and that if we, or those whom we love, are found in the path or in lesser soil, that we can quickly move them back to the good soil. Please pray for those who need to be moved, that they will hear the word of God and be transformed by it!

The Eucharist Transforms Believers into Christ's Body

Participation in the Eucharist transforms believers into the body of Christ and offers a remedy to the divisions affecting families and communities, Pope Leo XIV said during his weekly general audience June 24. Pope Leo also encouraged young people to use the downtime of summer vacation to attend Mass, go to confession frequently, reflect on Scripture, go on spiritual retreats and pilgrimages and spend time with loved ones.

"Vacation is a time for rest and to seek signs of God in the beauty of creation," he said in his remarks to Polish-speaking visitors. He also asked people to pray for students so that they may "choose wisely" the schools and universities they will attend and "discern with prudence their vocation."

Continuing his series on the documents of the Second Vatican Council, the pope focused on "Sacrosanctum Concilium," the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, explaining how the Eucharist draws the faithful into deeper communion with God and one another. Receiving Christ in the Eucharist transforms believers into the body of Christ, whose head is the risen Lord seated at the right hand of the Father, the pope said. "Thus, the Eucharist is the sacrament of the Kingdom that is to come," Leo said. The Eucharist teaches Catholics to adopt Christ's way of self-giving love and to be "drawn day by day into ever more perfect union with God and with each other," he said. "This gift draws us into the dynamic of unity, offering a powerful antidote to the forces of division that undermine our world, our communities, our families, and our hearts," he said.

"Dear brothers and sisters, let us draw with faith from this source of divine life and allow ourselves to be transformed by the mystery we celebrate," he said.

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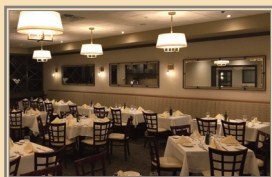
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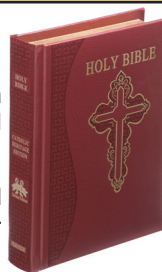


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
