From Fr. Mike's Desk

"God our Father, from living stones your chosen people; you built an eternal temple to your glory. Increase the spiritual gifts you have given to your Church, so that your faithful people may continue to grow into the new and eternal Jerusalem. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ your Son, who lives, and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, God forever. Amen."

This is the opening prayer for the feast of the Anniversary of the Dedication of a Church. Today, we remember **The Feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John in the Lateran**. This day is so important that it takes over the usual Liturgy for a Sunday of Ordinary Time. Why? Well, it is because this particular Church is known as *the Mother Church of all Rome*, and thus it becomes **the Mother Church of the Whole World**. This one church represents the joys and struggles that Christians experienced from the beginning, when the Church was declared illegal by Rome and subject to waves of persecution during its first three hundred years of existence. However, when Constantine became a Christian and Christianity became the only legal faith of the Empire, all this changed. A place of worship was erected in the wing of the home of the Laterani Family that was being used by the emperor. Today, this Church is the Pope's Church and the location of the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, which means that this is the true location of the Papal Throne. That is what makes this Church the Mother Church of Rome and of the Christian World. This day also reminds us of the universality of the Church; it reminds us that we can find the Church in every part of the world and in every part of human life.

The words of Saint Paul in today's *Letter to the Corinthians* remind us that the Church is not the buildings, the institutions, or the Pope, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Religious Sisters and Brothers, or Lay Leaders alone. Saint Paul reminds us that these are only a part of the Church, and that the true Church is all of those who are baptized. As he writes, *"Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"* The people of God are the true Church, the very stones that Jesus refers to, in part, when He tells the officials at the Temple, *"Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up'...But he was speaking of the temple of his Body."* Jesus not only speaks about the resurrection of His body, but also about the life we will gain as we live our lives as members of the Church. So, on this day, we

celebrate the Mother Church in Rome, and we celebrate the Church of Rockville Centre and most especially the Church in Syosset and Woodbury.

Jesus calls us to build up His Church every day by what we say and do. We are commanded by our Savior to join together every Sabbath to celebrate the Eucharist and to pray for the peace and salvation of the world. That is what happens every time we gather to celebrate Mass. The more who are present, the more that is gained. Please encourage all those you know to come, even if it has been a long time since they were here. They truly will receive much more than they give. And of course, we are called to support the Church with our time, talents, and treasure, and we should ask ourselves, are we doing enough, and can I give more monetary support to help the Church conduct its mission in this world?

Thank you for all that you do for Saint Edward's and Holy Name of Jesus. May God bless you always!



Did You Know...

Tomorrow, November 10th we celebrate the Feast Day of **Pope Leo I** (c. 391 – 10 November 461), also known as **Leo the Great**. He was Bishop of Rome from 29 September 440 until his death on 10 November 461. He is the first of the three Popes listed in the *Annuario Pontificio* with the title "the Great", alongside Popes Gregory I and Nicholas I.

Leo was a Roman aristocrat. He is perhaps best known for meeting Attila the Hun in 452 and persuading him to turn back from his invasion of Italy, though how large a part his personal authority played is debated, and some argue that Attila was already ready to end his campaign. He is also a Doctor of the Church, most remembered theologically for issuing the Tome of Leo, a document which was a major foundation to the debates of the Council of Chalcedon, the fourth ecumenical council. That meeting dealt primarily with Christology and elucidated the definition of Christ's being as the hypostatic union of two natures, divine and human, united in one person, "with neither confusion nor division". It was followed by a major schism associated with Monophysitism, Miaphysitism and Dyophysitism. He also contributed significantly to developing ideas of papal authority.


