From Fr. Mike's Desk

"At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

Today's Gospel Reading brings us back to the Gospel Reading we saw on May 10th, the Sixth Sunday of Easter. If you will recall, Jesus tells us in John's Gospel that He will not leave us orphans; that He and the Father will send another Advocate (God the Holy Spirit) to be with us always. Today's Gospel also shows us how Jesus will not leave us orphans, as He tells us He will not leave us as sheep without a shepherd. The shepherd who He sends in His name was at first the 12 Disciples, who He named Apostles (those who were especially sent). These twelve were given authority over unclean spirits and were able to cure every disease or illness. These shepherds were able to build the Kingdom of Heaven, as they told people it was at hand!

Of course, these shepherds were the first to receive the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, but they were not the last to receive the Fire, Grace, and Love that the Spirit poured over the whole Church and continues to do for every generation and for all nations. Notice the twelve who were called to be shepherds in His name. They were fishermen, tax collectors, zealots, and other tradesmen. They came from every walk of life and were called by God to give up their old ways and take on the Ministry of a Shepherd, giving their whole life for the good of the sheep. They come from the great love of Jesus' Heart.

Today we also remember special shepherds whom God has put into our lives, and that is fathers. And so, we offer a prayer for them written by Rev. Chuck Currie.

We give our thanks, Creator God for the fathers in our lives. Fatherhood does not come with a manual, and reality teaches us that some fathers excel while others fail. We ask for your blessings

for them all and forgiveness where it is needed. This Father's Day we remember the many sacrifices fathers make for their children and families, and the ways-both big and small- they lift children to achieve dreams thought beyond reach. So too we remember all those who have helped fill the void when fathers pass early or are absent, grandfathers and uncles, brothers and cousins, teachers, pastors and coaches and the women of our families. For those who are fathers, we ask for wisdom and humility in the face of the task of parenting. Give them the strength to do well by their children and by You in Your Holy Name. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

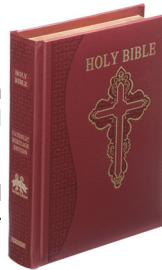


