From Fr. Mike's Desk

"When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came a noise from the sky like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now, there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language... 'Are not all these people speaking Galileans? ...yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God.'"

Pentecost Sunday, the last day of the Easter Season and the first day of the next week of Ordinary Time, tells us of the great coming of God the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and our Dear Blessed Mother. This day is aptly called the Birthday of the Church (which is now 2026 years old) because with the coming of the Spirit, the Church can now take its proper place in God's plan for Salvation History. At the Easter Vigil, on Holy Saturday Night, we retraced Salvation History from Genesis to the Gospel Account of the Resurrection. On this day of Pentecost, we are now commissioned to do our part to proclaim that Jesus Christ is the world's salvation. But we can only do this through the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit, for no one can say Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit (as St. Paul tells us).

The Father and the Son send the Holy Spirit to dwell in the Church so that the Spirit may be the Soul of the Church. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit enables the Church to teach, to sanctify, and to be governed as one unified, living Body of Christ. The Holy Spirit reminds us of all Jesus taught and shows us all that Jesus continues to do in the world. Through the Grace of God given to us through the power of the Holy Spirit, we can make Christ present in the Word and in the Sacraments of the Church. Remember, the Holy Spirit changes the Bread and Wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, and it is by the Holy Spirit that sins are forgiven in Reconciliation/Confession. The grace of the Holy Spirit helps married couples and gives Deacons, Priests, and Bishops what is necessary to conduct their Sacred Office of Ministry to, and in the Church.

The Holy Spirit dwells in each of us and empowers us from the moment of our Baptism, and through the

gifts received in Confirmation. The spirit helps us to live out our Christian Vocation(s); without the outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, we would not be able to do what Christ commands. So now we must ask ourselves, are we allowing the Holy Spirit to come into our lives so that we can do our part in Salvation History?

Let us pray, Father of light, from whom every good gift comes, send your Spirit into our lives with the power of a mighty wind, and by the flame of your wisdom open the horizons of our minds. Loosen our tongues to sing your praises in words beyond the power of speech, for without your Spirit we could never raise our voices in words of peace, or announce the truth that Jesus is Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit

God forever and ever.

Care for Our Common Home

"The external deserts in the world are growing, because the internal deserts have become so vast". For this reason, the ecological crisis is also a summons to profound interior conversion. It must be said that some committed and prayerful Christians, with the excuse of realism and pragmatism, tend to ridicule expressions of concern for the environment. Others are passive; they choose not to change their habits and thus become inconsistent. So what they all need is an "ecological conversion", whereby the effects of their encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in their relationship with the world around them. Living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience.

The Pope, an Observatory, and God's Creation

On Tuesday, May 19, Pope Leo XIV visited the Vatican Observatory in Castel Gandolfo and greeted the religious, lay and scientific staff. This was not the Pope's first time in the Observatory, as he had visited the space on July 20th, 2025, on the 56th anniversary of the Moon landing. During that visit, the Pope recalled that Pope Leo XIII re-founded the Vatican Observatory in 1891, at a time when science was being presented as a rival source of truth to religion. The 19th-century Pope said he was re-founding the institution so that, "everyone might see clearly that the Church and her Pastors are not opposed to true and solid science, whether human or divine, but that they embrace it, encourage it, and promote it with the fullest possible devotion." However, in our own times, both faith and science face a more insidious threat from those who deny the very existence of objective truth, said Pope Leo. "Contemplating the heavens invites us to see our fears and failings in the light of God's immensity," he said. The Pope went on to lament that man-made light has blinded us to the lights God has placed in the heavens, which he said makes the work of the Vatican Observatory more important than ever.

In conclusion, Pope Leo XIV urged the faithful to never lose sight that the Christian religion is based on the Incarnation, since God made Himself known through His Creation and sent His only Son to redeem it. "The hunger to understand Creation more fully," he said, "is nothing less than a reflection of that restless longing for God, which lies at the heart of every human soul."

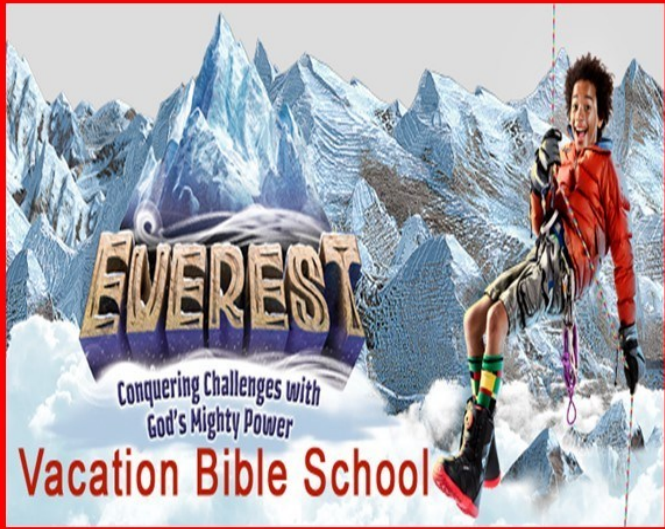

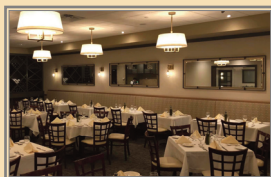

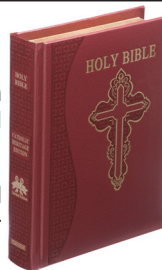
