## From Fr. Mike's Desk

"All powerful God increase our strength of will for doing good, that Christ may find an eager welcome at His Second Coming, and call us to His side in the Kingdom of Heaven. Father in Heaven; our hearts desire the warmth of your love, and our minds are seeking the light of your word. Increase our longing for Christ, so that at the dawn of His coming He may find rejoicing. Amen"

This prayer tells us what our focus should be as we begin our new Liturgical Year. The Church begins its year, a month or so, before the secular new year, so we can prepare ourselves for the great gift of Christmas. However, the Church is not focusing on the celebration of Christ's Birth the way the secular world does. While we all love some of the images, let's face it, who does not love Santa and Rudolph, and do not forget the Christmas Specials, while they are entertaining and full of cheer, they, for the most part, forget Jesus. The Church calls us to a better focus. The Advent Season reminds us that Christ is coming again, and we must be ready. While it seems strange that we begin the season with its ending, we are really reminding ourselves why God sent His only Son to be one of us in the first place.

Our readings, especially the Gospel readings, again tell us to stay awake, because we do not know when Christ will come again, and that would mean that the world has come to its completion. In today's reading, Jesus comments on how people were acting just before the days of Noah. They were living their lives with no regard for God or others. They refused to listen to Noah, and by the time they took notice, it was already too late. Jesus is telling us that we must be attentive to God's voice and live out the Gospel teachings. If we stay awake, allow ourselves to be prepared, and make Christ the total focus of our lives, we are closer; however, there is one more thing. To fully get ready, we must be open to receiving the power and the Grace of God, the Holy Spirit. By doing this, we are not only ready to celebrate His Second coming, but we are also truly preparing ourselves to celebrate the first coming.

When we see the Son of God as an infant, we see His innocence, humility, love, and holiness. Remember, on Christmas, we celebrate the incarnation of God as one of us. As I often say, at Christmas, humanity became better than before.






