From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Jesus said to his disciples; 'The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy buys that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls...'"

Last week and this week Jesus speaks about what the Kingdom of Heaven could be compared to: a Mustard Seed, Yeast in Flour, Buried Treasure in a Field, a Pearl of Great Price, or a Net Thrown into the Sea. Yet, Jesus never tells us what it is, even though its establishment is a key part of the Gospel message.

There are two reasons for Jesus' lack of a total description. The first is that the Kingdom is a part of the ancient tradition of Israel, and that the Messiah would usher it in. The Jewish tradition was that the Kingdom is the consummation of history itself, and not just a reward for virtuous deeds throughout history. God completes salvation history by completing history itself (this is where the belief and the understanding of the end of the world comes about). Israel understood that the Kingship of God was seen in history, and that God is the God of history, but He went beyond history as well. The Kingdom was not just for the Jews, but for the Gentiles, for God intended that all things would come together in Himself. This universal Kingdom will bear fruit in a completely new moral order where the will of God is operative in this world, and all people will be working in God's peace given to us through the Messiah—who is the Prince of Peace. The Lord comes not to punish or judge, but to bring this radical peace, goodness, and salvation to all. This is how Jesus announced the Kingdom's arrival as we see throughout the four Gospels and the Epistles.

The second reason Jesus would not clearly speak about the Kingdom, except in parables, was for the same reason He never outwardly said that He was the Messiah. The Kingdom at Jesus' time took on overtones that were more nationalistic. Some saw it as the restoration of the rule to Israel as it was under David and Solomon. Some saw it as a great Apocalypse caused by God's sovereign will and the final intervention without any cooperation at all on the part of humanity. Jesus tells us that this is not the case when He tells us that the Kingdom of God is at hand and we will be invited into it, because God is a God of mercy and forgiveness. One's entrance will depend more on our response to, and our ability to show mercy, to forgive, and to help our neighbors in need. Jesus did not foresee a political kingdom, nor did He see a kingdom of the elite. The invitation to

come into the Kingdom is given to saints and sinners alike, to those who society accepts and to those who are considered outcasts or who society neglects or despises. What we need to enter God's Kingdom is CONVERSION. Conversion, the desire to do God's will, to love God with all your heart, and love your neighbor as yourself. From all this true salvation flows and the Kingdom comes as we accept the love that God the Father has shown us through His beloved Son, and by the Grace and Power of the Holy Spirit.

**Let us pray for the coming of the Kingdom
in the words our dear Savior taught us:**

**Our Father Who art in heaven,
hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come
Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread;
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation
but deliver us from evil. Amen.**

Magnificent Humanity

While Leo XIII spoke in his time of "new things", today we cannot limit ourselves simply to repeating his insightful teachings. Instead, we must ask God for the wisdom to interpret the great trends of our time, particularly technological advances. The power and prevalence of emerging technologies are interwoven into the fabric of daily life, shaping decision-making processes and deeply affecting the collective imagination: "Never has humanity had such power over itself."

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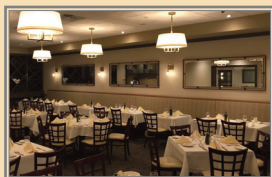
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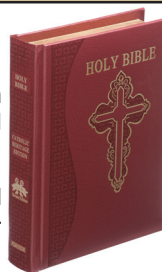


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
