## From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today is the last Sunday of Lent and the first day of Holy Week. During this week, we will liturgically walk through the last days and hours of Jesus' life. We will experience first the Last Supper with the Institution of the Eucharist, the finding of the Ministerial Priesthood, and the Washing of The Feet. On Good Friday, we will remember how Christ died on the Cross and destroyed sin, spiritual death, and darkness. On Holy Saturday, we will bless the Easter Fire, Candle, and Water. We will also retrace our Salvation History, in an extended Liturgy of the Word, and that will be followed by the conferring of the Easter Sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, and later Eucharist), all signs of the new life gained for us by the Resurrection of Christ. Also, remember that on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, we begin the day at 9 AM with Morning Prayer (as there is no Morning Mass on these days, also Funeral Masses are not celebrated on these days, but we are able to have a Liturgy of the Word).

Today, Palm Sunday presents us with the reading of the Passion according to Matthew. Notice that during Jesus' trial, Pilate asks the crowd who they would prefer to set free, Jesus or Barabbas. As we know, the crowd chooses Barabbas, and they tell Pilate to crucify Jesus! As the Gospel tells us, Pilate's plan was backfiring, and the crowd was getting ugly. So, he gave in to their desire and handed Jesus over to them to be tortured and die on the Cross. No matter how hard he tried, Pilate failed to get out of the situation of facing injustice, political intrigue, and the jealousy of the Jewish Leadership. Pilate could not escape his fate, and he had to act. Many, of course, believe that Pilate did the wrong thing by allowing an innocent man to be executed. Certainly, killing Jesus was an injustice, but from the standpoint of a Roman Governor, Pilate couldn't care less. To him, Jesus was a carpenter from Nazareth whom he regarded as a troublemaker, and, to top it off, he believed that Jesus told them not to pay their taxes to Rome. Also, Pilate needed the cooperation of the High Priests if they were to help him maintain order, which Pilate's superiors in Rome expected. So, he had no choice but to side with them, and so poor Jesus was going to die on that Friday Afternoon.

Now, if we look at these sorrowful events from a Divine point of view, Pilate was doing what needed to be done, so that salvation could come to all humanity. While it was indeed unjust to kill this innocent man, it was indeed an act of Divine justice; for through Christ's death, the scales of Divine justice were

balanced. God the Father has provided us with the cure for Original Sin and Spiritual Death, and all things that stand between God and humanity. He who was without sin gave up His life to forgive the sins of all, even those who yelled out the loudest, Crucify Him! No matter how hard he tried to avoid the situation, Pilate had to respond to where and what God called him to do. This Holy Week reminds us that we, too, must respond to Christ and try not to avoid His call in our lives or to take the steps He wishes us to take for our salvation. In John's account of the Passion, which we will read on Good Friday, Pilate asks Jesus if He is a king. And Our Lord answers, "You say I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." Please keep in mind that in Baptism we were called to listen to and bear witness to the truth, the Truth which is Christ. We cannot hide from it or look for some spiritual loophole, as Pilate tried. No, we must embrace what God is calling us to do through His Son.

We will hear confessions tomorrow, Monday, March 30th, from 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm, as part of the Diocesan Day for Reconciliation. Please see the opposing page of the bulletin for the schedule of services for Holy Week and next Sunday, Easter.

The Hour of Darkness

\* **Tenebrae** - “Watch and pray,” Jesus tells his apostles in the garden of Gethsemane, “that you may not enter into temptation.” He invites them to pray for courage and strength as they will be confronted with His betrayal, arrest, false condemnation, passion and crucifixion. We, who are baptized into Jesus’ death and resurrection, also hear His call, especially in Holy Week, to watch and pray as we commemorate these most sacred and life-giving days in our own lives and in the history of the world.

The major liturgies of The Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday, the Good Friday Service and the great Easter Vigil are our principal ways of prayerfully commemorating the events that won our salvation. But our Tradition also offers other ways to watch and pray during these holy days. The Liturgy of the Hours is prayed with great intensity and beauty during Holy Week. Many of you join the Office of Morning Prayer which our parish celebrates on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday mornings.

As we did last year, we will again be praying an evening office in the ancient Christian **tradition known as Tenebrae**. The word is Latin for darkness. The office commemorates the growing darkness enveloping Jesus as he faces the betrayal and arrest that lead to his passion. As the psalms are prayed and the scriptures are read, the candles of the church are extinguished one by one until the church is left in darkness. A loud thunder sound is heard. One lit candle remains, hidden away, as a sign that the darkness cannot completely overcome the Light, that the Cross leads to Resurrection.

Tenebrae is one of the most moving services of Holy Week. It offers a wonderful opportunity to “watch and pray” as we enter into these sacred days. Join us on April 16th, the Wednesday night of Holy Week at 7:30 PM and enter into this great prayer experience.

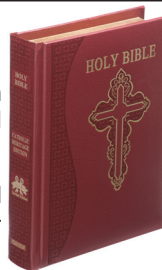
