From Fr. Mike's Desk

"In the name of The Father and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit. Amen." Every Roman Catholic, Orthodox Christian, and some other Christians begin their prayers, Liturgical Celebrations, with these words as they make the Sign of the Cross. These words remind us of who it is we are directing our prayers to, namely our dear Lord, who is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. What does it mean when we refer to God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and why do we refer to God this way? Well, that is easy; that's how God exists (for lack of a better word). Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is one of the days on the Church's Calendar which focuses on one of the major mysteries of our Faith, and this is one big mystery. On this day, we try to explain and celebrate the Triune Nature of the One True God. Oh, sure, we could get away with the idea that it is a mystery, so that is all we can say, but that is not good enough and not what God expects. God, throughout time, has been revealing Himself and this Triune Nature to us. One such explanation of God existing in the Blessed Trinity is seen in the Creed attributed to Saint Athanasius. St. Athanasius was the Patriarch of Alexandria who lived from 298-373 AD. While this statement of faith and doctrine is attributed to him, many believe he did not write it because it was written in Latin and not in the Greek he would have used. And its contents fit more with the theology of the Western Church and of Church Scholars from a later time than he lived.

As the Creed States, "...And the Catholic Faith is this: That we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity, neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the substance. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit. But the godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit is all one, the glory equal, the majesty co-eternal. Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit. The Father uncreated, the Son uncreated, and the Holy Spirit uncreated. The Father is incomprehensible, the Son incomprehensible, and the Holy Spirit incomprehensible. The Father eternal, the Son eternal, and the Holy Spirit eternal. And yet they are not three eternals, but one eternal. Also, there are not three incomprehensible, nor three uncreated, but one uncreated, and one incomprehensible. So likewise, the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, and the Holy Spirit is almighty. And yet there are not three almighties, but One Almighty. So, the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three gods but only One God. So likewise, the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, and the Holy Spirit is Lord, and yet not three Lords, but One Lord. For we are compelled by the Christian verity [truth] to acknowledge each Person by Himself to be both God and Lord, so we are also forbidden by the Catholic Religion to say that there are three gods or three lords. The Father is not made, neither created, nor begotten. The Son is of the Father alone, not made, nor created but begotten. The Holy Spirit is of the Father, neither made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding. So, there is one Father, not three fathers; one Son, not three sons; one Holy Spirit, not three holy spirits. And in the Trinity, none is before or after another; none is greater or less than another, but all three Persons are co-eternal together and co-equal. So that all things are as aforesaid, the Unity in Trinity and Trinity in Unity is to be worshipped. He, therefore, that will be saved must think thus of the Trinity."

Now I am sure that this answers any questions that you may have about the Blessed Trinity, if not, do not worry, after all, it is a mystery. Just keep in mind what our readings tell us today, that all of God has been working and participates in our salvation. That every part of God will stop at nothing so that we can be free of sin, darkness, and spiritual death.

On behalf of Fr. Hyacinth, Fr. Jude, Msgr. Beckmann, Deacon Jim and Deacon Barry, and the staff of St. Edward's, we wish a very Happy and Blessed Father's Day to all our fathers and prayers for our fathers who have gone home to the Kingdom
