

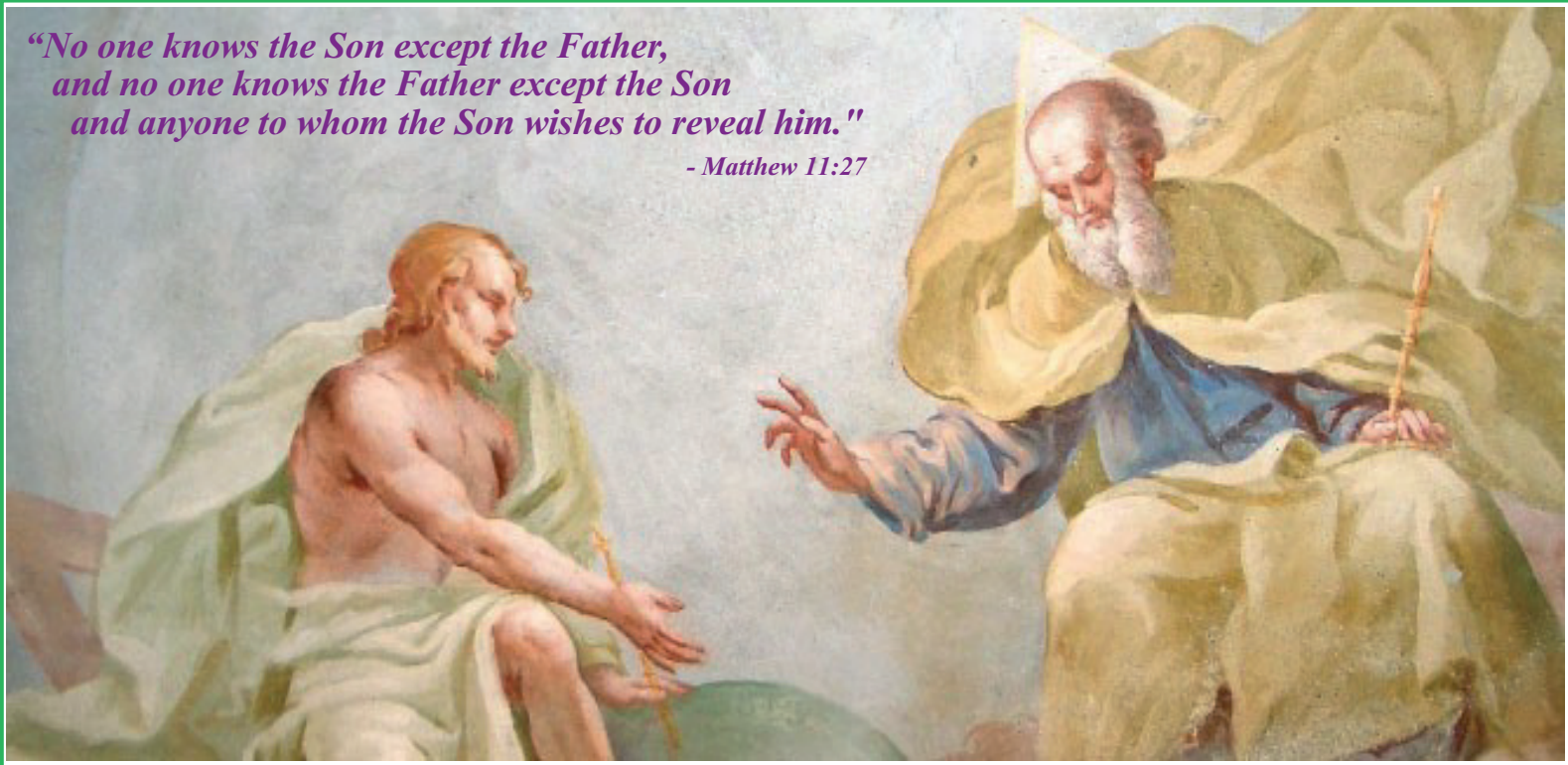

From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Jesus said to his apostles: 'Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me...'"

Today, Jesus continues where He left off last week on what it takes to be His disciple. Last week, we were told that persecution was a part of a disciple's life and that we would face opposition. We were also told not to fear anyone who could harm the body, only those who could kill the soul. As we left off, in this space, that person could be anyone, even ourselves, if we gave in to fear or worldly ideas. In today's Gospel, Jesus expands the definition of those who could kill the faith within us to those who are close to us. Now, please keep in mind that Jesus is not telling us to go out and hate our family members and close friends, or that we should cut them out of our lives. However, when we remember His original audience, we must remember that it was hard for them to follow Jesus. This was true if they were Jews or everyday citizens of the Roman Empire. In either case, they could be disowned by their family and, in some cases, turned over to the authorities. Faced with this, many decided not to become followers, or many new Christians would give up their faith, or secretly follow Jesus. Jesus is telling them not to let anybody, even immediate family, get in the way of genuinely loving and serving the Father through Him.

This, of course, is true for many people in our own time who are seeking to follow Jesus, but family and friends get in the way. Jesus is telling them the same thing. Sometimes, as mentioned above and last week, people might do the same to us, and we are not to let them get in our way. *Saint Paul* tells us in today's *Letter to the Romans*, that we have died with Christ and so should believe that we should live with Him. Why, because the Risen Lord can die no more, and death has no power over Him or over us who died with Him in the waters of Baptism. Therefore, as Jesus tells us, whoever loses his life [his old life] for my sake, will find his true life. Jesus continues

by telling us how we should proceed when we live our lives in Him. We are to go out like Prophets and Righteous People, spreading the Gospel in how we act and speak. We are to let people see Christ alive in us and know that whoever receives us as a prophet or righteous person will receive the one who sent us.

We will not be greeted like Elisha, who in the first reading had a room prepared for him by the couple who knew he was a prophet, but those who have the spark of faith in their hearts certainly will accept us. When this happens, and it happens more than you may realize, then you will receive the prophet's and righteous person's reward. You will grow closer to Christ, and the Holy Spirit will empower you even more so!

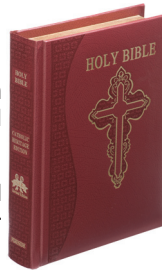


