## From Fr. Mike's Desk

Several years ago, I shared with you the story of a funeral I attended for my classmate Father Martin Klein. On May 25, 1991, nine of us were ordained priests for the Diocese of Rockville Centre. Over the years, four members left the ministry, leaving five of us to continue with the mission. Now with Fr. Klein returning to God, that leaves only four of us. You may have noticed Fr. Marty's last name. Normally, his name would be associated with a Jewish person, and in this case, it was. If you have not already guessed, Fr. Marty became a Catholic Christian in the early 1980's. Delivering the homily at the Mass was his very good friend, Msgr. Thom Costa, who was at the time the director of the Pius X Home for Retired Clergy. Msgr. Costa explained that Fr. Marty would tell people he converted for one remarkably simple reason. He fell in love with Jesus Christ. According to Msgr. Costa, Fr. Marty loved the passage from John's Gospel, "For God so loved the world that He sent His only Son..." This passage allowed him to focus on God's plan for salvation; one could say that he was transformed by Christ. More than being transformed, Fr. Marty was transfigured, for he saw God in a new way. A way that allowed him to say that he was still Jewish, but now he was a complete Jew, as he found Christ and became one with Christ (as we all do through Baptism). While his transfiguration may not be visible to others (as Jesus did when He appeared in today's Gospel), it was manifested by Fr. Marty's actions and his dedicated service to God and the Church for almost 29 years.

When Peter, James, and John saw the Transfigured Jesus, they saw Him in a way they had never seen Him before, and they saw Him in a way that showed His true Divine Nature. While they did not totally understand the nature of the Incarnation of the Son of God, they now knew that there was more to Jesus than met the eye. We, too, can see more of Jesus when we look at Him through the eyes of faith. Like the Apostles, we can say Lord, it is good for us to be here, not to try to capture the moment, but to allow it to capture us and change us. How can we do this if it did not totally change the Apostles who were there? Well, it did change them, but not right at that moment. They were changed after they saw the Risen Lord on Easter Sunday. When Jesus appeared to them exactly the way He did on the mountain. They were changed when they received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, just as we were through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. We also change every time we receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Remember, when we

receive the Eucharist, we are totally receiving the Body and the Blood, the Soul, the Humanity and Divinity of Jesus. This is why the Eucharist is also called the True or Real Presence. It is not a symbol or just a reminder of Jesus; it truly is Jesus. Jesus, coming to us in a Sacramental Form. So many people (even Catholics) do not understand this, and we must go out and help them! We can do this when we allow ourselves to be transfigured. We can do this when we, like Fr. Marty, fall deeply in love with Jesus.

We close with the following prayer:

*O God, who in the glorious Transfiguration of your Only Begotten Son confirmed the mysteries of faith by the witness of the Fathers and wonderfully prefigured our full adoption as your children, grant to your servants that listening to the voice of your beloved Son, we may merit to become co-heirs with Him. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever.*  
*Amen*






