

#### FEBRUARY VICAR'S VAGARIES

Through February, the readings at Eucharist will center on Jesus' early ministry, emphasizing God's active presence and transformative power. On February 2<sup>nd</sup>, we celebrate the Presentation of Jesus at the Temple, stepping away from the usual Sunday readings. This feast's Gospel recounts Simeon and Anna recognizing Jesus as the Messiah, highlighting divine revelation and fulfilled prophecy. Simeon's *Nunc Dimittis* proclamation bridges the Old Testament promise and its New Testament fulfillment.

Following this, we explore Jesus' baptism, the temptations in the wilderness, and his initial miracles and teachings. These texts underscore Jesus' divine authority and mission, calling believers to recognize and respond to God's revelation. The Baptism of Jesus, a profound manifestation of the Holy Trinity, signals the start of his ministry and reminds us of our baptismal calling. The temptations in the wilderness explore spiritual discernment, and Jesus' miracles and teachings emphasize love, mercy, and justice, challenging us to embody these values.
