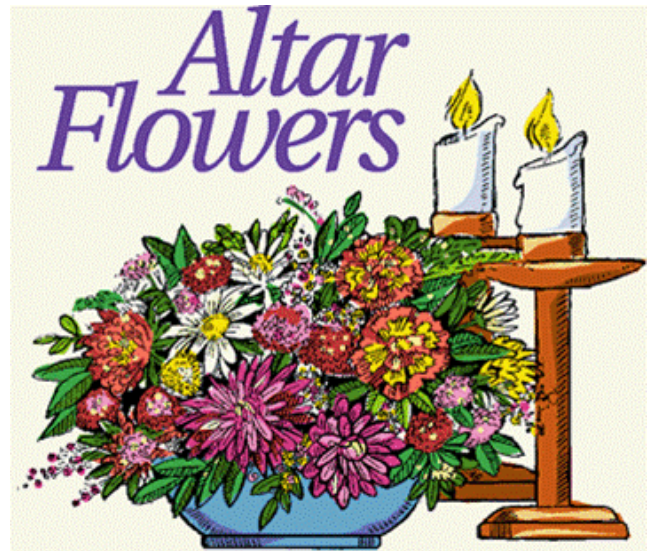


Flower Chart
