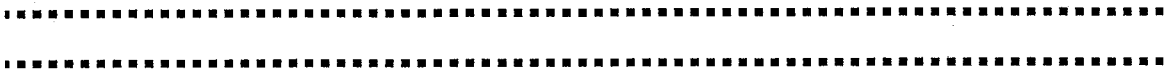

### **From the Rector:**

Years ago something strange happened to me. The church that I was serving had a Wednesday evening prayer service for healing. It began about 9pm, and one Wednesday evening I was very tired, and went to the meeting before its start and told the the other people I would like a night off. They happily dismissed me and home I went.

I got home (next to the church), put my feet up and relaxed. But I felt guilty and could not be at peace while people were praying next door and I was not there. It was as if "a voice" were saying to me; "you need to be there or one teammate in prayer will be missing". So, half way through the 30 minute session, I went back into the chapel and sat guilty in the back row. Big deal I thought...are you happy now, God? Can I go home and rest now?

As I was preparing to leave, a lady stopped us all and asked to listen to her statement; she said that we had been praying for some months for her grandson and his drug problem, and that this past week he had disavowed the drugs and the drug friends he associated with, and that he was determined to recover. And she thanked us all for praying for him each week and how much it had meant to her. We had been a huge encouragement to her through our gathering together for prayer. I would not have missed that moment for the world!!!

Now I understood why "the voice" had dragged me out of my easy chair. That I was not attending prayer for me---but for them. And that when we are absent from some activity--we probably never consider what effect it will have on the group that is meeting. We are needed even when we don't see the value in our participation.

The first part of the document discusses the importance of maintaining accurate records of all transactions. It emphasizes that proper record-keeping is essential for the integrity of the financial system and for the ability to detect and prevent fraud. The document also notes that records should be kept for a minimum of seven years.

The second part of the document outlines the procedures for the collection and distribution of funds. It states that all funds received should be deposited into a designated account within a specified time frame. The document also describes the process for disbursing funds to authorized personnel, including the requirement for proper documentation and approval.

The third part of the document discusses the responsibilities of the various personnel involved in the financial process. It outlines the duties of the accounting staff, the treasurer, and the board of directors, and emphasizes the importance of clear communication and collaboration among all parties.

- 1. The accounting staff shall be responsible for the accurate recording of all transactions.

- 4. All personnel shall be required to maintain the highest standards of integrity and honesty.
- 5. Any suspected or actual fraud shall be reported immediately to the appropriate authorities.

It is the policy of the organization to maintain the confidentiality of all financial information. Any unauthorized disclosure of such information shall be considered a serious violation of the organization's policies and may result in disciplinary action. The organization also reserves the right to audit the financial records of any personnel at any time.

The document concludes with a statement of the organization's commitment to transparency and accountability. It expresses the organization's confidence in the financial system and its ability to manage the organization's resources effectively and responsibly.

The document is signed by the Treasurer and the Board of Directors, and is dated as of the date of the meeting.
