Church Care

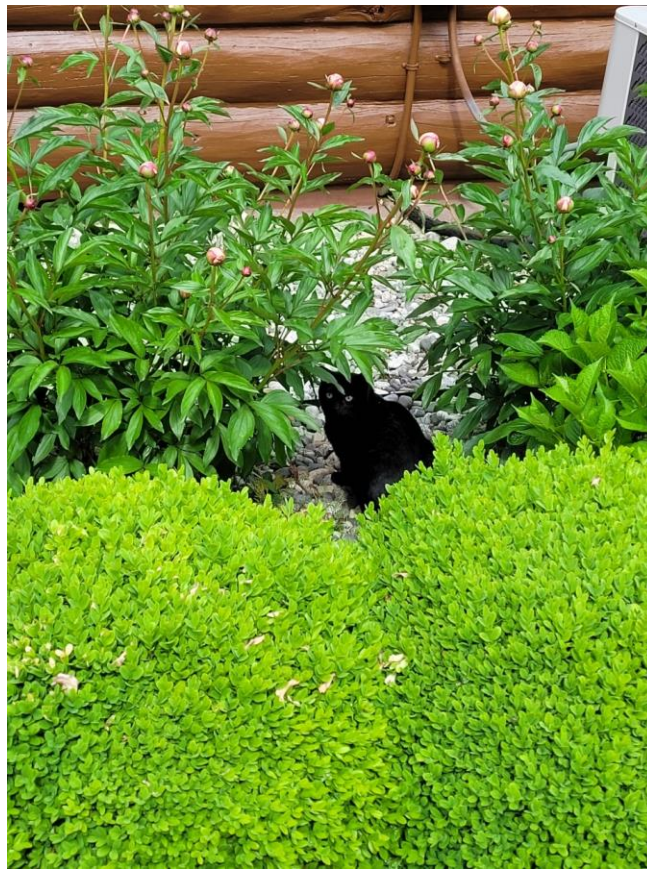
