He was very active in sports and scouting, while growing up. He was a member of the Boy Scouts of America and earned the rank of Eagle Scout. Darrell graduated high school from Oroville, WA, and then attended and graduated from Washington State University, with a degree in horticulture. He loved attending WSU, and was a member of the WSU wrestling team.



The Rev. Bill Osborne, rector of St. Stephen's in Spokane, is leading a pilgrimage to the Holy Land next year at the start of Lent, from February 28-March 11, 2023. This trip is run by Lightline Pilgrimages, a Christian tour company that is the "preferred partner" of the Diocese of Jerusalem.
