Bishop Visitation

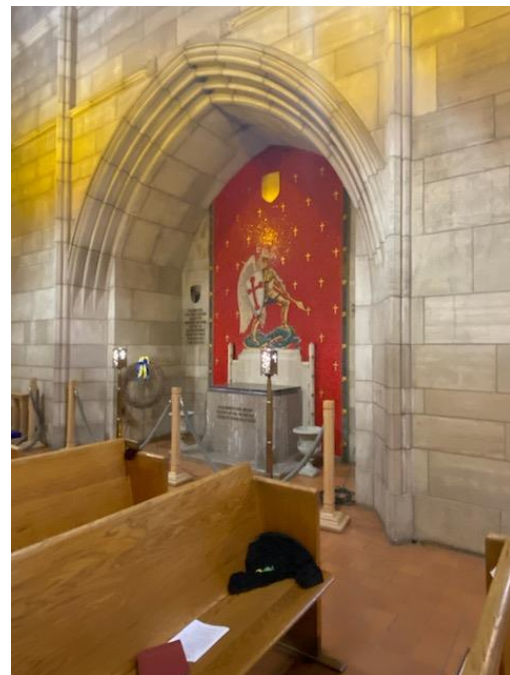

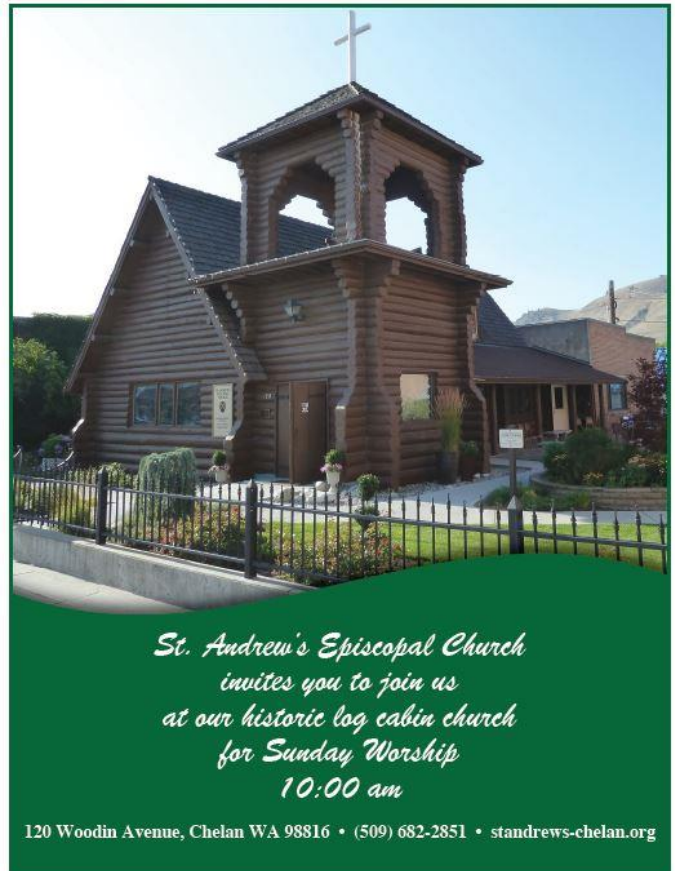
