

I started this body of work with a further mediative investigation into spontaneous colour field painting. Working them up till an image appeared - something like cloud gazing.



When the earth appeared in painting 13! I decided to explore an idea of our stewardship of the earth. With a series of work - a model representing us holding the planet earth - our world. Layered on an abstract landscape ground inspired by the vast inhospitable dry interior of our country. The figure is grounded with a strong shadow. The shadow dark however not black, still transparent, still penetrable. Our dark side, our unknown; is our balance - penetrable.

Can we save our living environment? Even if we

haven't caused global warming - To survive - We need to maintain a liveable atmosphere. To use our higher intellect, to inherit the earth. We could integrate with the abundant energy and maintain our environment instead of choking ourselves. Can we think as creators not serfs?

The earth is in our hands.

Gwion accidently drinks of Ceridwens cauldron, a potion made for her son - a gift of wisdom. Fearing Ceridwens roth Gwion transforms himself into a hare but Ceridwen pursued in the form of a hound; he changed into a fish and she into an otter; he changed into a bird she into a hawk; lastly he became a grain of wheat and she pecked him up into her crop as a hen. He was reborn of her womb nine months later as the infant poet Taliesin.

Through his totemic associations with the different animals and plants – which represent a getting of knowledge – the poet is able to know what happened in the past and what will happen in times to come. Thus becoming chief bard story teller by prophecy and far memory.

Stalking stealthily up dry creeks, to the tree fern hill, under which we'd find a trap. The Heiferlump had barged straight through; leaving a note – ha – scratched on a bit of shale, there was no sign of the crystal. Grandfather laughing, checking the next trap – you'll need to try harder than that – or – can't catch me.

The Heiferlump is my point of transcendent reality - a locus which is my mythical and actual at once - a place of initiation. Each individual has a different experience therein. However only my self is enabled by this – to know about what I find there.




