- **HARDSHIP WAIVER***

When you are asking for a close relative to remain in the country to obtain residence

- **U-Visa***

If you are a crime victim who have suffered substantial mental, physical or sexual abuse.

- **T-Visa**

If you are a victim of human trafficking

- **VAWA**

Violence against Women Act – if you are a battered spouse or child.

- **POLITICAL ASYULUM**

If you are unable or unwilling to return to your home country because of persecution or a well-founded fear of persecution on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.
