## Operationalize and Prepare for Authorization

Establish clear systems for enrollment, governance, compliance, and student supports such as MTSS, ESE, and ELL. Finally, prepare for your authorizer interview and public hearing with a deep understanding of your proposal and the ability to clearly articulate your school's value.
