California Republican County Parties

(Republican Central Committees)

- Each county elects a Central Committee to oversee the county's Republican Party activities (voter outreach, registration drives, fundraising etc.).
- Central Committee members are elected from Assembly Districts or County Supervisor Districts on the Presidential primary ballot.
- Vacancies on Central Committee can be filled by appointment.
- See your county Republican Party for information on Central Committee members, vacancies, meeting times and places.
- Closest elected official to the voter.

PRECINCT

Precinct Committeemen (Not In California)

- Dan Schultz's precinct committeemen program is based on elected precinct committee members which California does not elect.
- California Republican County Parties organize their Get Out the Vote (GOTV) programs utilizing volunteers.
