YCRCC held public meetings at Pioneer Hall in Wheatland, and at our HQ in Marysville. The purpose of the meetings was to select candidates for YCRCC to endorse. In advance of the meetings, **Kristina Villanueva** mailed questionaires to all the Republican candidates.

Only registered Republicans can be endorsed by YCRCC. Each candidate at the meetings gave a brief presentation as to why they should be elected. This was followed by questions from **Johanna Lassaga** and other voting members of YCRCC.



With only voting members of YCRCC present, there was discussion as to which candidates YCRCC should endorse. It was refreshing to have some first-time Republican candidates run for school boards, city councils, and water districts.

Opposition to School Bonds



YCRCC is actively opposing these Plumas Lake bonds. If all

these bonds pass, the property taxes in Plumas Lake will go up \$144 per \$100K of assessed value. These proposed bonds are on the ballot after Plumas Lake residends voted against similar Measures V and W Bonds in the March Primary.

The Wheatland School District Supervisor makes more than the Govenor in salary and benefits. If more money is needed for schools, trimming costs should be the first consideration. If Plumas Lake chooses to form a separate high school district by passing these bonds, then a lot of tax dollars will be spent on a newly created Superintendent and other overhead positions.
