California is finally heading in the right direction. With YCRCC's help,many counties flipped from blue to red for the election of our President.

**Kamala** got far fewer California votes than **Biden**, but **Trump** got more than he did in 2020.

Prop 36 winning is a huge repudiation of Newsom's urging Californians to vote against it. He wanted it defeated, but Prop 36 won by a 68.4% to 31.6% margin. This


