November Meeting Highlights

Mac Young, Chair of the Nevada County GOP, was



unanimously elected as the temporary chair of YCRCC so that an impartial organizational election could be held. The first order of business was to elect **Kristina Villanueva** as temporary secretary so that the revised YCRCC Bylaws could

be approved. After the new Bylaws were unanimously approved, **Johanna Lassaga** was unanimously re-elected as the YCRCC Chair. This was followed by **Kristina Villanueva** being unanimously elected to be our Secretary and **Tom Pessoa** being unanimously elected as Treasurer. The two Vice Chair seats will be filled at a later date.

Mac reported the Republican Party gained ground in the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, Grass Valley City Council, Nevada Irrigation District, Nevada Joint Union High School District, and the Pleasant Ridge School District.

Mac's fiancée, **Susan Walsh**, with their dog Trump (note the dog's right ear - Hee Hee) gave a presentation on a new bi-partisan effort to recall **Newsom**. As more and more Californians and businesses are exiting California, even Democrat contributors are in favor of getting rid of **Newsom**.

Dom Belza, former Marysville City Councilman, let it be



known that he will be running to fill **James Gallagher's** Third Assembly District seat that is up against term limits.
