

What is Ombre Powder?

Ombre powder brows soft shading is the newest permanent makeup technique using a digital machine. It is 100% customizable and is great for anyone who wants to enhance their eyebrows with a soft and natural makeup-like finish.

What is Microshading?

Micro+ shading is a combination of both powdered brows and the 3D hair like strokes of microblading. This method uses both manual and machine techniques to create natural strokes in the inner front of the eyebrows with a soft, make up like finish on the whole eyebrow.

How long does it last?

All methods generally last 1-3 years. Results vary depending on skin type, conditions, and how natural or defined you want the eyebrows to look.

What is the process?

Each appointment begins with a full consultation, outlined shaping of the eyebrows, and procedure.

Do I get to see and pick my own eyebrow shape and color?

Yes, you will see the shape and color customized for you.

Does it hurt?

A topical anesthetic will be applied during the consultation process to minimize any discomfort. The pain level is minimal to none for most clients.

How long does it take?

The consultation and appointment will take about 2 hours.

What is the healing time and after care?

Typical heal time is about 7-14 days. During this time, avoid getting eyebrows wet, sweating, and heavy sun exposure. Do not pick at or touch your eyebrows. After 48 hours, daily ointment should be applied.

How much does it cost?

The first session is \$500. A \$100 non refundable booking deposit is required for every session and deducted from that appointment's total cost. Touch up sessions are \$250. An additional \$100 fee will be added to the first correction session for clients with previous work not done by Hailey. Missed appointments will be fully charged with no refunds.

Are there allergic reactions?

An allergic reaction to pigments is extremely rare and can be waived. A patch test is available to all clients. A patch test appointment must be booked and performed 3 weeks before the treatment. The patch test includes a light prick to your skin to test topical numb, needle, and pigment behind the ear.

Is semi-permanent makeup similar to actual tattoos?

Semi-permanent make up is considered a tattoo because we are implanting pigment into the superficial layers of the skin. It does not puncture deep enough to be a permanent tattoo and safe pigments used are designed to fade gradually over time.

Is this procedure safe?

This method is completely safe and less invasive than a body tattoo. Proper aftercare is advised for perfect healed results. All materials used are medically pre-sterilized, sealed and brand new for each client.

Is this procedure guaranteed?

Like any other cosmetic procedures, semi-permanent make up is not guaranteed as the skin anatomy is different for each individual. Lifestyle and immune system may play a huge factor in the longevity and retention of the pigment.

How long should I wait before I can have permanent make up applied after botox, injections, chemical peels, or laser treatments?

You should wait at least 3 weeks before and after the treatment until you have reached your desired outcome of your brows before doing the following. Avoid heavy creams and strong ingredients directly on top of the eyebrows in order to increase the longevity of your eyebrows.
