



THE BEGINNING

Peter Silvester of Royal African Safaris and Humphrey, pioneered the helicopter safari in Kenya and East Africa in the late 1990s.

Humphrey set up Lady Lori Kenya Ltd, with the help of owner and investor, Jim Denooyer and his wife Lori (hence the name!). It started out as a company to promote and support the conservation initiative, Loisaba Wilderness, which Peter, Jim, Lori and others invested so much of their lives to establish.



With Jim's generosity, Peter's imagination, and Humphrey's curiosity, it became a thriving and successful business of its own, whilst still supporting and promoting Loisaba.

Peter and Humphrey created tailor-made adventures in the wild and vast landscapes of northern Kenya, following the most scenic routes and touching down spontaneously to take in magnificent views.

Humphrey's safaris have always combined a feeling of freedom with the joy of flight. They unveil the geographical wonders of nature, whilst creating a truly amazing and unforgettable experience.



HUMPHREY'S EDUCATION

Humphrey was educated at Stowe School in England and the The Royal Military Academy Sandhurst. He gained a commission in the Irish Guards and for 4 years flew helicopters on operations as a pilot in the Army Air Corps.





A POSSIBLE DAY TRIP FROM NAIROBI - BIG CATS DIARY



Example of a Scenic Day Trip to the Maasai Mara via Lake Magadi, Lake Natron and Nguruman Mtns

Route: Nairobi, via Lake Magadi, Lake Natron & the Maasai Mara, returning to Nairobi


Flying Hours: 3 Hours

Depart Wilson Airport heading west toward the Great Rift Valley, plunge down the escarpment into the Rift, fly over the famous Olorgesailie Prehistoric Site, then on to Lake Magadi to view startling pink flocks of Lesser & Greater flamingoes bright against the blinding white salt of the lake.

After a Picnic Breakfast on Lake Magadi Island, you'll cross the Ngarenaro Swamp, view the unforgettable beauty of Shompole Mountain and the blood-red, salt-encrusted pools of Lake Natron before swooping up to the Nguruman Escarpment. Here, as you float effortlessly through dramatic gorges and skim ancient trees, you'll see the sparkle of clear streams and waterfalls & spot elephants & buffalo in the dense forest below. You'll drop down to the valley floor & follow the Southern Ewaso Ng'iro River towards Mt Suswa - a great open caldera - then west again to the Maasai Mara ready for a game drive and a delicious lunch surrounded by the abundant plains game and the famous big cats of Kenya's best loved conservation area.

Leave the Maasai Mara with the long evening shadows stretching ahead of you, to reach Wilson Airport before the sun sets on a rare and special day

Wildlife to Find: Elephant, Rhino, Lion, Cheetah, Leopard, Buffalo, Wildebeest, Hyena, Zebra, Antelope and much much more!
