Plans and Programs Connected to the Theme

1. Kingdom Growth Institute - *A yearlong discipleship and leadership training program.*

How it supports the theme: Investing in the Kingdom of God begins with investing in spiritual formation. This institute develops believers who are rooted in Scripture, disciplined in prayer, and trained to serve with excellence.

Expanded Components:

- Foundations Track: Essentials of faith, doctrine, prayer, and Christian living.
- Leadership Track: Training deacons, trustees, ministry leaders, and emerging leaders.
- Teaching Ministry Track: Equipping teachers for Sunday School, Bible Study, and youth ministries.
- Service & Missions Track: Preparing members for evangelism, outreach, and mission engagement.
- Monthly Kingdom Intensives: Workshops that address spiritual gifts, stewardship, and Kingdom purpose.

Kingdom Impact: When believers grow spiritually and become fruitful workers, the church becomes a stronger investor in God's Kingdom.

2. Community Investment Projects - *Food drives, clothing outreach, and neighborhood cleanup initiatives.*

How it supports the theme: These initiatives are tangible investments in the lives of people. Jesus teaches that serving others is serving Him (Matthew 25:35–40). By blessing the community, the church demonstrates Kingdom love and purpose.

Expanded Components: Monthly Food Distribution: Feeding families and seniors in need. Clothing Closet Ministry: Providing seasonal clothing to children, adults, and the homeless. Neighborhood Beautification Days: Cleaning streets, repairing homes, and improving safety. Adopt-A-School Partnership: Supporting local students and teachers through supplies and mentoring. Senior Care & Visitation Ministry: Visiting the sick, homebound, and nursing home residents.

Kingdom Impact: The church becomes a light in the community, building trust, relationships, and opportunities to share the Gospel.

3. Faith & Finance Workshops - *Teaching stewardship and biblical financial management.*

Building Generational Wealth: Estate planning, insurance literacy, and legacy giving. Entrepreneurship & Career Development Nights: Helping members maximize gifts and opportunities. Church-Wide “Time, Talents, and Tithing” Emphasis: Connecting personal resources to Kingdom purpose.

Kingdom Impact: Financially strong believers help build a financially strong church able to do greater ministry.

4. Youth Empowerment Academy - *Developing faith, character, and leadership among youth.*

How it supports the theme: Investing in the Kingdom requires investing in the next generation. This academy nurtures young people spiritually, emotionally, academically, and socially.

Expanded Components: Youth Bible Academy: Weekly Scripture training for spiritual growth. Leadership Development Groups: Teaching responsibility, service, and life skills. Academic Support & Tutoring Lab: Helping youth excel in school. Teen Entrepreneurship Program: Encouraging creativity, business skills, and future planning. Mentoring Circles (Boys & Girls): Giving godly guidance through one-on-one mentorship. Youth Worship Sundays: Empowering youth to serve in music, worship, ushering, and media.

Kingdom Impact: Strong youth today build a stronger Kingdom church tomorrow.

5. Family Enrichment Ministry - *Strengthening homes through prayer, counseling, and fellowship.*

Family Prayer Revival Nights: Monthly home-centered prayer gatherings. Grief, Trauma & Restoration Counseling: Healing wounded hearts and restoring broken places. Family Fellowship Events: Picnics, game nights, trips, and unity-building activities.

6. Media & Technology Expansion - *Enhancing the church's online presence and worship experience.*

Media Training Team: Teaching youth and adults how to use cameras, sound, and graphics for ministry. Website Expansion: Sermon library, ministry pages, and community resources.
