COMMUNITY PARKING

A reminder about street parking at the Villas at Fived Ponds.

- Five Ponds Circle—illegal to park on both sides of the street.
- Villa Drive—illegal to park on the non-sidewalk side (these are signed with "Ps" with red line through them) and illegal to park on sidewalk side at curves and where streets meet. (these are signed with "No Parking Signs")
- Fairway Drive—illegal to park on the non-sidewalk side (these are signed with "Ps" with red line through them) and illegal to park on sidewalk side at curves and where streets meet. (these are signed with "No Parking Signs")
- Clubhouse Lane—illegal to park on the non-sidewalk side

The areas that are marked with the "No Parking Signs" are considered "Fire Zones."

CLUBHOUSE PARKING

Due to several Clubhouse parking lot issues this past season, the Rules Committee recommended expanding the parking regulations. The board approved the following updates to the rules:

- Vehicles parked in the clubhouse parking lot due to a winter weather event must remove their vehicle from the lot within 24 hours of completion of community snow removal (streets and all residential driveways). This will enable our snow removal vendor to properly clear the clubhouse parking lot. Cars must be parked in only the two center rows starting at the end closest to the pool entrance. 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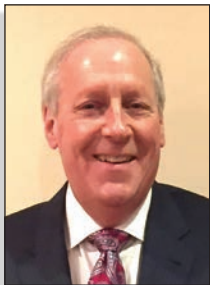

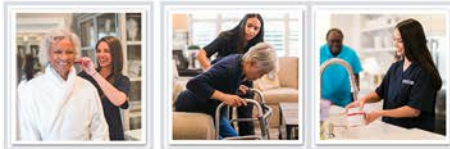

2026 PHILADELPHIA EAGLES SEASON PREVIEW

IT MAY NOT FEEL LIKE IT but the Birds are only a couple of weeks away. In what ended in rather lame fashion last year, a similar Eagles team has been in training camp and preseason, ready for another 17 weeks of regular season football.

2025-2026 Result: 11-6, first round loss in playoffs to San Francisco 49ers.

2026 Super Bowl Odds: 16-1 (Tied for 4th best odds.)

Coaching: While Head Coach Nick Sirianni and Defensive Coordinator Vic Fangio have kept their roles, new offensive coordinator Sean Mannion comes into play. This is the fourth offensive coordinator that the Eagles have had in four seasons, with Mannion making his offensive coordinator debut in the midnight green and white. Long time offensive line coach Jeff Stoutland retired, with Chris Kuper taking over, coming over from Minnesota.



Offense: Despite the loss of AJ Brown at wide receiver, I would make the argument that the Eagles offense got better (and if not better, than most definitely deeper). Marquise Brown, Dontayvion Wicks and Makai Lemon will all be floating around for the #2 wide receiver position beside Devonta Smith. The offensive line, along with Hurts, Saquon and Dallas Goedert remain the same, and the Birds should have a top offense yet again led by their skill players.

Defense: While the offense got better, I feel like the defense may have gotten worse. Losing Reed Blankenship, Sydney Brown and Nakobe Dean feels like a tough pill to swallow. Jonathan Greenard was the big signing at \$98 million to improve the defensive line. Riq Woolen will look to bring his winning ways from Seattle to be beside Quinyon Mitchell and Cooper Dejean in the secondary.

Special Teams: Unchanged minus what was a revolving door at long snapper last season, Rocco Underwood (a rookie from Florida) will get the first crack at it.

Jake's Take: The Rams are the HEAVY favorites to win the Super Bowl this year at 11/2, and they are loaded. However, the expectation should be for the Eagles to be in playoffs yet again. They have the 3rd

best odds in the NFC, and are solid favorites to win the NFC East division for the 3rd season in a row.

Do I think Super Bowl aspirations may be a little too high? Maybe, but that's why they play the game.

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“THE NOTEBOOK” BY NICHOLAS SPARKS

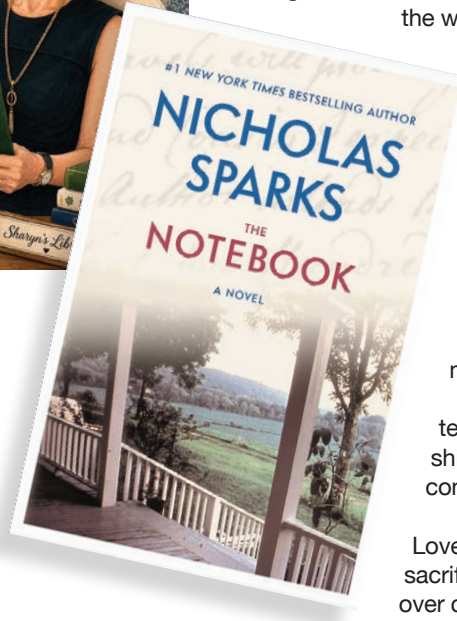
I RECENTLY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY to see the musical “The Notebook”. It was not depressing as some might think. The play focused on the enduring love that Noah Calhoun and Allie Nelson had for each other rather than the infirmities of old age. There were humorous moments as well as meaningful songs.

I had never read the book which was published in 1996 or seen the movie version. After seeing the show, I became interested in reading the book. I am so glad I did.

At this stage of our lives many of us are dealing with the loss of our spouses or are caring for spouses that have physical or mental impairments.

The book tells the story of two young lovers from different backgrounds whose romance is cut short when Allie’s parents disapprove. Years later after WWII, Noah restores an old plantation home, while Allie becomes engaged to another man that meets her parent’s standards for her. However, their feelings for each other don’t vanish.

The novel also features a parallel story line with an elderly man named Duke, who reads their love story to a woman in a



nursing home who suffers from dementia. In a touching reveal, readers learn that Duke is Noah and the woman is Allie. He reads to her daily in the hope that it will bring back memories. Though her memory is fading, she shows signs that she remembers the love they shared for many years.

Major themes include the endurance of true love, the challenges of memory and aging, social class differences, loyalty and the power of commitment.

What makes it special is how tender and believable the relationship feels. Even a broken heart continues to beat.

The ending is bittersweet. Love requires patience and sacrifice. They chose commitment over convenience.

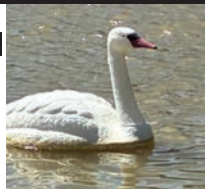
