





SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: THE BEST SINCE TIGER

SPORTS ARE FILLED with hot takes. All of the analysts that are paid to talk sports go on the TV, podcasts, radio and spew some opinions that often have very little truth attached. I'm going to attempt to make a take that is not so hot.

Scottie Scheffler has been on an absolute tear. He has won 17 PGA events over the past 41 months of golf, including 4 major tournaments in the last 16 major opportunities. He has been the #1 player in the world for the past 149 weeks and is still in the thick of his prime at only 29 years old.

He's doing it in a different way, he isn't flashy at anything in particular. He doesn't have Phil Mickelson's short game, Tiger's distance or Ben Crenshaw's putter, but he is truly above above (yes, I wrote above 3 times) average in pretty much every category. One of my favorite statistics in golf (data nerd) is called "Strokes Gained". It shows how many shots you are better or worse than the average PGA Tour player in every category (Putting, Around the

Green, Approach, Off The Tee). Scottie is a full 3.19 shots better than the average player per every round this season after being 3.22 shots better last year and 2.73 shots better in 2023. You can see it visually here.



So... is the Tiger comparison that outlandish? Eh, you tell me. It took Tiger and Scottie the EXACT same number of days (1,197 to be exact) from his 1st major win to his 4th major win. From 2002-2005, Tiger played 78 events, won 18 times including 4 majors. From 2022-2025, Scottie played 81 events, won 20 times including 4 majors.

The only one that can really be grouped close to Scottie since the Tiger days would be Rory McIlroy. Rory turned professional in 2007, has won 29 times on the PGA Tour including 5 majors. Scottie turned professional in 2020, has collected 17 PGA wins including 4 majors... ahead of Rory's pace. Scottie has plenty of room before he catches Tiger (82 PGA wins, 15 majors for "The Cat") but we better respect his greatness. He's the best we've had in a long long time.



LOOKING FOR A GOOD PLACE to meet up with several friends

for a special Sunday lunch, I received a tip about a newly renovated restaurant only 23 minutes from The Villas at Five Ponds.

Our party of four met at Scoogis Italian Kitchen & Bar in Flourtown - an easy trip-just a few minutes from the 309 turnpike exit. It has a large private parking lot and accessible entrance.

Inside, the newly updated décor is sleek, contemporary, and quite comfortable. We were promptly seated and served by a very cordial waiter, who took our drink order and returned with fresh sliced Italian bread and oil for dipping.

As a starter, I had Pasta e Fagioli - a hearty tomato broth generously loaded with white cannelloni beans, ditalini, garlic, and Parmesan. A wonderful rendition of a classic, done with care and served handsomely.

For my entrée, I chose the Mediterranean Salad: with a base of fresh mixed greens, it was topped with chilled jumbo shrimp, large white chunks of cab, a hefty piece of grilled salmon, roman artichokes, red onion, grape tomatoes,

Kalamata olives, feta, and a substituted choice of a hearty Blue Cheese dressing. Just amazing in impressive visual presentation and

taste appeal.

My luncheon partners ordered generous side salads along with Chicken Parmigiana and Eggplant Parmigiana. All dishes were well received and enjoyed.

Quite satisfied, we just couldn't pass up the offering of a good fresh cannoli and Philadelphia's own Bassetts Ice Cream. I had the special flavor of the day: a salted pretzel/ caramel/fudge delight that was certainly a topper on a very impressive meal.
